ORDER:

The Registrar General, High Court of Madras in his proposal read above, has stated that the High Court, in consultation with the Principal District Judge, Vellore, recommends for constitution of a District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court at Anaicut in Vellore District. In this regard, he has stated that among the total number of 1531 civil cases pending on the files of the existing Principal District Munsif Court, Vellore and Additional District Munsif Court, Vellore, 380 cases are arising from the territorial jurisdiction of Anaicut Taluk. Further, out of the total number of 442 criminal cases pending before the Judicial Magistrate Courts No.I, III, IV & V, Vellore, 220 cases are arising from the territorial jurisdiction of Anaicut Taluk.

- 2. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras has, therefore, requested the Government to issue orders for constitution of a District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court at Anaicut in Vellore District with requisite posts and other requirements.
- 3. In the meantime, the Hon'ble Minister for Law, while moving the Demand for Grants relating to Administration of Justice (Demand No.3), has made, among others, the following Announcement on the Floor of the Assembly on 27.04.2022:-

"Constitution of a District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court at Anaicut in Vellore District".

4. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras, have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government order for constitution of a District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court at Anaicut in Vellore District at a total cost of Rs.1,61,16,696/- (Rupees one crore sixty one lakh sixteen thousand six hundred and ninety six only) (i.e. Rs.1,45,34,696/- as recurring expenditure and Rs.15,82,000/- as non recurring expenditure) by sanctioning the following posts and other infrastructure facilities.

- 5. The incumbents of the posts sanctioned in para 4 above are eligible for pay and other allowances as per orders in force.
- 6. The Director of Stationery and Printing, Chennai is requested to supply two Tamil Typewriters and two English Typewriters and other stationery items at free of cost for the proposed constitution of the District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court at Anaicut in Vellore District.
- 7. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is directed to send necessary draft notifications to the Government for its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, under the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 [Central Act III of 1873] and Code of Criminal Procedure 1973 for the commencement of the above said court.
- 8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following heads of account:

The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course of time by an inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period up to next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to the Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras shall also send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2022-2023 to Finance (BG-II/Home-II) Department at the appropriate time, without fail.
