From the Registrar General, High Court of Madras letter Roc.No.8115/A/2019/G/Judn, dated 03.01.2020 and 08.04.2022.

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ORDER:

The Registrar General, High Court of Madras in his letter read above, has stated that after considering the request of the Bar Association and also in consultation with the Principal District Judge, Tiruchirappalli recommends the proposal for constitution of a Sub Court at Musiri in Tiruchirappalli District. In this regard, he has stated that out of the 7694 cases pending on the file of the existing Principal Sub Court, I Additional Sub Court, II Additional Sub Court, III Additional Sub Court, Tiruchirappalli as on 31.10.2019, 824 cases including 347 Original Suits, 115 Appeal Suits, 11 RCAs, 13 CMAs, 159 HMOPs, 46 EPs, 50 IPs, 5 LAOPs and 78 Sessions cases are arising from the territorial jurisdiction of the proposed Sub Court, Musiri. The total number of 347 Original Suits arising from the territorial jurisdiction of Musiri is more than the norms fixed by the High Court for constitution of a Sub Court at Musiri and reveals the need for constitution of a Sub Court at Musiri in Tiruchirappalli District.

2. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary orders for constitution of a Sub court at Musiri in Tiruchirappalli District with posts and other requirements. He has also requested the Government for the attachment of the Copyist Establishment and Nazir Establishment now functioning at the District Munsif Court, Musiri to the proposed Sub Court, Musiri.

3. In the meantime, the Hon'ble Minister for Law, while moving the Demand for Grants relating to Administration of Justice (Demand No.3), has made, among others, the following Announcement on the floor of the Assembly on 27.04.2022:-

"Constitution of a Sub Court at Musiri in Tiruchirappalli District".

4. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government accord sanction for a sum of Rs.1,82,20,932/- (Rupees one crore eighty two lakh twenty thousand nine hundred and thirty two only) [viz. Rs.1,65,48,932/- as recurring expenditure and Rs.16,72,000/- as non recurring expenditure] towards constitution of Sub Court at Musiri in Tiruchirappalli District by sanctioning 20 new posts and other infrastructure facilities.

- 6. The incumbents of the posts sanctioned in para 4 above are eligible for pay and other allowances as per orders in force.
- 7. The Director of Stationery and Printing, Chennai is directed to supply stationery articles, requisite forms and registers to the above said court at free of cost against the specific indent of the Judicial officer concerned.
- 8. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is requested to send necessary draft notifications to the Government for its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, under the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 [Central Act III of 1873] for the commencement of the above said court and also to send the draft Notification under first proviso to section 13 of the said Act to be published by the High Court, for approval of the Government.

The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is directed to calculate the actual amount required for period up to next Supplementary Estimates and sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to the Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras shall also send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2022-2023 to Finance (BG-II/Home-II) Department at the appropriate time, without fail.
- 11. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.23762/Home-II/2022, dated 18.05.2022, PSL No.202205PSL0167 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.176 (One hundred and seventy six).
