ORDER:

The Secretary, Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India, New Delhi in his D.O. letter 1st read above, has stated that the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, vide G.S.R.163 (E) dated, 25.02.2022, had published "Compensation to Victims of Hit and Run Motor Accidents Scheme, 2022" in supersession of the Solatium Scheme, 1989, which was issued vide SO 440 (E), dated 12.06.1989. The new scheme will be effective from 01.04.2022.

- 2. The Secretary, Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India, New Delhi, has further stated that as per rule 11 of the Scheme, a District Level Committee has to be constituted in each District to undertake all functions connected with the implementation of this Scheme at the District Level.
- 3. In this connection, the Transport Commissioner in his letter 2nd read above has requested the Government to constitute a District Level Committee in each District with the following members for smooth implementation of the "Compensation of Victims of Hit and Run Motor"

Accidents Scheme, 2022" introduced by the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India, New Delhi as follows:-

- 4. The Transport Commissioner has stated that the above mentioned committee is to evaluate the progress of implementation of the Scheme in concerned District and should take corrective measures wherever necessary. The District level committee will monitor the flow of compensation amount to the Road Accident victims / legal heirs.
- 5. The Transport Commissioner has further stated that the General Insurance Council shall prepare an annual report on the working of this scheme and submit the same before the standing committee with a copy marked to Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Central Government. He has therefore requested the Government to implement the above scheme for the formation of District Level Committee as it is very essential.
- 6. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of Transport Commissioner has decided to constitute District Level Committee in each District with the following members for smooth implementation of the "Compensation of Victims of Hit and Run Motor Accidents Scheme, 2022" introduced by the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India, New Delhi:-
