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### ORDER:

The Registrar General, High Court of Madras in his letter read above, has stated that the High Court, after considering the request of the Bar Association, Vandavasi and in consultation with the Principal District Judge, Tiruvannamalai recommends the proposal for constitution of a Sub Court at Vandavasi. In this regard, he has stated that out of the 3063 cases pending on the file of the existing Sub Court, Cheyyar as on 31.08.2020, 1144 cases including 460 Original Suits, 34 Civil Appeals, 117 EPs, 83 OPs, 58 HMOPs, 366 MCOPs and 16 Sessions cases are pending as on 31.08.2020 are arising from the jurisdiction of Vandavasi Taluk. The total number of 460 Original Suits arising from the territorial jurisdiction of Vandavasi is more than the norms fixed by the High Court for constitution of a Sub Court at Vandavasi in Tiruvannamalai District.

2. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary orders for constitution of a Sub court at Vandavasi in Tiruvannamalai District with posts and other requirements. He has also requested the Government for the attachment of the Copyist Establishment and Nazir Establishment now functioning at the District Munsif Court, Vandavasi to the proposed Sub Court, Vandavasi.

3. In the meantime, the Hon'ble Minister for Law, while moving the Demand for Grants relating to Administration of Justice (Demand No.3), has made, among others, the following Announcement on the floor of the Assembly on 27.04.2022:-

"Constitution of a Sub Court at Vandavasi in Tiruvannamalai District".

4. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government accord sanction for a sum of Rs.1,74,03,768/- (Rupees one crore seventy four lakh three thousand seven hundred and sixty eight only) [viz. Rs.1,57,60,268/- as recurring expenditure and Rs.16,43,500/- as non recurring expenditure] towards constitution of a Sub Court at Vandavasi in Tiruvannamalai District by sanctioning 18 new posts and other infrastructure facilities as detailed below:-

6. The incumbents of the posts sanctioned in para 4 above are eligible for pay and other allowances as per orders in force.

7. The Director of Stationery and Printing, Chennai is directed to supply stationery articles, requisite forms and registers to the above said court at free of cost against the specific indent of the Judicial officer concerned.

8. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is requested to send necessary draft notifications to the Government for its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, under the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 [Central Act III of 1873] for the commencement of the above said court and also to send the draft Notification under first proviso to section 13 of the said Act to be published by the High Court, for approval of the Government.

The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course of time by an inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period up to next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to the Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras shall also send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2022-2023 to Finance (BG-I/Home-II) Department at the appropriate time, without fail.
