ORDER

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued, among others, for sanction and constitution of a District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court at Kundrathur in Kancheepuram District with posts and other requirements.

2. Pursuant to this, Registrar General, High Court of Madras, has sent draft notifications under sections 4 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873) for the purpose of constitution of the District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court at Kundrathur in Kancheepuram District with a request to publish the same in Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

3. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar-General, High Court of Madras, Chennai, have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government direct that the following Notifications shall be published in Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION-I.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the first paragraph of section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby alters the number of District Munsifs to be appointed under the said Act for Kancheepuram District as five with effect from the date on which the District Munsif assumes charge of the District Munsif's Court at Kundrathur.

NOTIFICATION – II.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the second paragraph of section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after consultation with the High Court, Madras, hereby fixes the number of District Munsifs to be appointed for the District Munsif's Court at Kundrathur in Kancheepuram District as one with effect from the date on which the District Munsif assumes charge of that court.

NOTIFICATION – III.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby directs that, in the District of Kancheepuram, the Subordinate Judge's Court at Kancheepuram shall have and exercise original jurisdiction over the District Munsif's Court at Kundrathur, in addition to its existing jurisdiction with effect from the date on which the District Munsif assumes charge of the District Munsif's Court at Kundrathur.


