ORDER

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued for sanction of a Subordinate Judge's Court at Vandavasi in Tiruvannamalai District with posts and other requirements.

- 2. Pursuant to this, the Registrar-General, High Court of Madras, has forwarded draft notifications under sections 4, 5 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873) for the purpose of constitution of a Subordinate Judge's Court at Vandavasi in Tiruvannamalai District with a request to publish the same in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.
- 3. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar-General, High Court of Madras, have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the following Notifications shall be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION - I

In exercise of the powers conferred by the first paragraph of section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby alters the number of Subordinate Judges to be appointed under the said Act for Tiruvannamalai District as eight with effect from the date on which the Subordinate Judge assumes charge of the Subordinate Judge's Court at Vandavasi.

NOTIFICATION-II.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the second paragraph of section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after consultation with the High Court, Madras, hereby fixes the number of Subordinate Judges to be appointed for the Subordinate Judge's Court at Vandavasi in Tiruvannamalai District as one with effect from the date on which the Subordinate Judge, Vandavasi assumes charge of that Court.

NOTIFICATION - III.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby fixes Vandavasi in Tiruvannamalai District as the place at which the Subordinate Judge's Court, Vandavasi shall be held.

NOTIFICATION - IV.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby directs that in the District of Tiruvannamalai, the Subordinate Judge's Court at Cheyyar shall cease to have jurisdiction over the District Munsif Court, Vandavasi and hereby fixes the local limits of the District Munsif Court, Vandavasi as the local limits of jurisdiction of the Subordinate Judge's Court at Vandavasi with effect from the date on which the Subordinate Judge, Vandavasi assumes charge of that Court.
