#### ORDER:

The Registrar General, High Court of Madras, in his letters read above, has stated that the High Court, after considering the request of the Bar Association, Kodumudi and in consultation with the Principal District Judge, Erode recommends a proposal for constitution of a Sub Court at Kodumudi. In this regard, he has stated that out of the 4313 cases pending on the file of the existing Sub Courts, Erode (Principal Sub Court, I and II Additional Sub Courts and Special Court for MCOP cases) as on 30.06.2020, 364 cases including 269 Original suits, 76 MCOPs, 19 EPs cases are arising from the territorial jurisdiction of the proposed Sub Court at Kodumudi in Erode District. The total number of 269 Original Suits arising from the territorial jurisdiction of Kodumudi justifies the need for constitution of a Sub Court at Kodumudi in Erode District.

2. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras has, therefore, requested the Government to issue orders for constitution of a Sub Court at Kodumudi in Erode District with requisite posts and other requirements. He has also requested the Government for the attachment of the Copyist Establishment and Nazir Establishment now functioning at the District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court, Kodumudi with that of the proposed Sub Court, Kodumudi to form a Central Nazerath Establishment and a Central Copyist Establishment on the constitution of a Sub Court at Kodumudi.

3. In the meantime, during the Budget Session of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for the year 2022-2023, the Hon'ble Minister for Law, while moving the Demand for Grants relating to Administration of Justice (Demand No.3) has made, among others, the following Announcement on the floor of the Assembly on 27.04.2022:-

"Constitution of a Sub Court at Kodumudi in Erode District."

4. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government accord sanction for constitution of a Sub Court at Kodumudi in Erode District with 20 new posts and other infrastructure facilities at a total expenditure of Rs.2,00,54,480/-(Rupees two crore fifty four thousand four hundred and eighty only) [viz. Rs.1,83,32,480/- as recurring expenditure and Rs.17,22,000/- as non recurring expenditure] as detailed below:-

- 6. The incumbents of the posts sanctioned in para 4 above are eligible for pay and other allowances as per orders in force.
- 7. The Director of Stationery and Printing, Chennai is directed to supply stationery articles, requisite forms and registers to the above said court at free of cost against the specific indent of the Judicial officer concerned.
- 8. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is requested to send necessary draft notifications to the Government for its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, under the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 [Central Act III of 1873] for the commencement of the above said court and also to send the draft Notification under first proviso to section 13 of the said Act to be published by the High Court, for approval of the Government.

The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course of time by an inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is directed to calculate the actual amount required for period up to next Supplementary Estimates and sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to the Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras shall also send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2022-2023 to Finance (BG-I/Home-II) Department at the appropriate time, without fail.
