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## ORDER

The Registrar-General, High Court of Madras, in his letter first read above, has stated that, the High Court, after considering the request of the Bar Association, Arakkonam and after considering the huge pendency of cases on the file of the existing Judicial Magistrate Court at Arakkonam, recommends the proposal for constitution of one more Judicial Magistrate Court at Arakkonam. He has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary orders for constitution of one more Judicial Magistrate Court at Arakkonam (formerly in Vellore District) in Ranipet District with 16 new posts and other requirements.

2. In the meantime, the Hon'ble Minister for Law, while moving the Demand for Grants relating to Administration of Justice (Demand No.3), has made, among others, the following Announcement on the floor of the Legislative Assembly on 10.04.2023:-

“Constitution of a Judicial Magistrate Court at Arakkonam in Vellore District”.

3. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar-General, High Court of Madras, have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government accord sanction for a total sum of Rs.1,40,74,200/- (Rupees one crore forty lakh seventy four thousand and two hundred only) [viz. Rs.1,24,80,200/- as recurring expenditure and Rs.15,94,000/- as non recurring expenditure] towards constitution

of one more Judicial Magistrate Court at Arakkonam in Ranipet District with creation of 16 new posts and other requirements/infrastructure facilities, as detailed below:-

4. The incumbents of the posts sanctioned in paragraph 3 above are eligible to draw pay and allowances as per orders in force.

5. The Director of Stationery and Printing, Chennai is directed to supply stationery articles, requisite forms and registers to the above said court at free of cost against the specific indent of the Judicial Officer concerned.

6. The Registrar-General, High Court of Madras is requested to send necessary draft notifications to the Government for its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, under relevant acts for the commencement of the judicial function in the above said newly created Judicial Magistrate Court.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 3 above shall be debited to the following heads of account:-

8. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 3 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course of time by an inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2023-2024. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Registrar-General, High Court

of Madras is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period up to next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to the Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Registrar-General, High Court of Madras shall also send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2023-2024 to Finance (BG-I/Home-II) Department at the appropriate time, without fail.


