ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above, among others, orders were issued for constitution of a Family Court in the cadre of District Judge at Karur in Karur District. In Government Order second read above, among others, the Family Court at Karur was notified and the Jurisdiction extended to the local limits of the Karur city inclusive of Karur Taluk has been published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

2. In the circumstances, the Registrar General, High Court, Madras, in his letter third read above has stated that, the Principal Subordinate Court and the Additional Subordinate Court in Karur and the Subordinate Judge's Court at Kulithalai are conducting trial on matrimonial case along with Original Suits, Appeal Suits, MCOP, LAOPs, Session cases and other cases and the pendency of matrimonial disputes in the Principal Subordinate Court and the Additional Subordinate Court in the Head Quarters of Karur District and Subordinate Judge's Court at Kulithalai are high, as the territorial jurisdiction of these courts covers all the other Taluks viz., Pugalur, Manmangalam, Aravakurichi, Kulithalai, Krishnarayapuram and Kadavur except Karur Taluk of

Karur District. The pendency of cases relating to matrimonial cases in the above said courts may be transferred and trial of these cases may be conducted in the Family Court, Karur (District Judge Cadre) which was constituted to conduct exclusive trial of all matrimonial disputes by extending the jurisdiction to extend the entire Karur District, by including the above taluks. Hence, he has requested to issue necessary amendment to the Government Order second read above for extension of Jurisdiction of Family Court, at Karur to the entire Districts and to cause the same published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

3. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras. Accordingly, the following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Family Courts Act, 1984 (Central Act 66 of 1984), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after consultation with the High Court of Madras, hereby increases the Jurisdiction of the Family Court at Karur to the entire District of Karur.
