ORDER:

The Registrar General, High Court of Madras, in his letters read above, has stated that the High Court, after considering the request of the Thiruthuraipoondi Bar Association and in consultation with the District Judge, Tiruvarur recommends the proposal for constitution of a Sub Court at Thiruthuraipoondi in Tiruvarur District. In this regard, he has stated that out of the 2294 cases pending on the file of the existing Sub Court, Mannargudi as on 30.11.2019, 2294 cases including 72 Original Suits, 65 Appeal Suits, 70 H.M.O.Ps, 120 M.C.O.Ps, 5 L.A.O.Ps, 48 E.Ps and 18 Session cases are arising from the territorial jurisdiction of the proposed Sub Court at Thiruthuraipoondi in Tiruvarur District.

- 2. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras has, therefore, requested the Government to issue orders for constitution of a Sub Court at Thiruthuraipoondi in Tiruvarur District with requisite posts and other requirements. He has also requested the Government for the attachment of the Copyist Establishment and Nazir Establishment now functioning at the District Munsif Court, Thiruthuraipoondi with that of the proposed Sub Court, Thiruthuraipoondi to form a Central Nazerath Establishment and Central Copyist Establishment, on the constitution of a Sub Court at Thiruthuraipoondi.
- 3. During the Budget Session of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for the year 2021-2022, the Hon'ble Minister for Law, while moving the Demand for Grants relating to Administration of Justice

(Demand No.3) has made, among others, the following Announcement on the floor of the Assembly on 7.9.2021:-

"Constitution of a Sub Court at Thiruthuraipoondi in Tiruvarur District."

4. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government order for the constitution of a Sub Court at Thiruthuraipoondi in Tiruvarur District at a total expenditure of Rs.1,19,77,000/- (Rupees one crore nineteen lakh and seventy seven thousand only) [viz. Rs.1,02,59,000/- as recurring expenditure and Rs.17,18,000/- as non recurring expenditure] by sanctioning the following 14 new posts and other infrastructure facilities.

The Government also order for the attachment of the posts sanctioned to the existing Nazerath Establishment and Copyist Establishment of the District Munsif Court, Thiruthuraipoondi with that of the newly sanctioned Sub Court, Thiruthuraipoondi to form a Central Nazerath Establishment and Central Copyist Establishment on the constitution of the Sub Court at Thiruthuraipoondi as detailed below:-

- 6. The Director of Stationery and Printing, Chennai is directed to supply two Tamil Typewriters and two English Typewriters, stationery articles, requisite forms and registers to the above said court at free of cost against the specific indent of the Judicial officer concerned.
- 7. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is requested to send necessary draft notifications to the Government for its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, under the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 [Central Act III of 1873] for the commencement of the above said court and also to send the draft Notification under first

proviso to section 13 of the said Act to be published by the High Court, for approval of the Government.

- 9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature shall be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the

contingency fund. The Registrar General, High Court is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period up to next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the contingency fund to the Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the contingency fund will be issued by the Finance (BG-I) Department. The Registrar General, High Court is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2021-2022 at the appropriate time without fail.
