# **ORDER**

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued, among others, for sanction of a District and Sessions Court at Kancheepuram in Kancheepuram District with posts and other requirements by converting the existing District Judge's Court No.II, Kancheepuram in Kancheepuram district.

2. Pursuant to this, the Registrar-General, High Court of Madras, has sent draft notifications (i) under sections 3, 4, 5 and 10 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), (ii) under sections 7(1), 7(2), 9(1) and 11(1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Central Act 2 of 1974) and (iii) under section 57(1) of the Provincial Insolvency Act, 1920 (Central Act V of 1920) for the purpose of constitution of the District and Sessions Court at Kancheepuram in Kancheepuram District with a request to publish the same in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

3. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar-General, High Court of Madras, have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government direct that the following Notifications shall be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-

# **NOTIFICATION - I.**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby establishes a District Court at Kancheepuram by converting the existing District Court No.II, Kancheepuram.

# **NOTIFICATION – II.**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby fixes the number of District Courts in the cadre of District Judge to be established for Kancheepuram District as two and also alters the number of District Courts in the cadre of District Judge for Chengalpattu District as three with effect from the date on which the District Judge, Kancheepuram assumes charge of that Court.

# **NOTIFICATION – III.**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873) and in supersession of all the previous notifications on the subject, the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after consultation with the High Court, Madras, hereby fixes the number of Subordinate Judges and District Munsifs for **Chengalpattu and Kancheepuram districts**, as specified in the Table below, with effect from the date on which the District Judge, Kancheepuram assumes charge of the District Court at Kancheepuram:-

### NOTIFICATION - IV.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 5 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873) and in supersession of all the previous notifications on the subject, the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby fixes Kancheepuram as the place at which the **District Court of Kancheepuram** shall be held with effect from the date on which the District Judge, Kancheepuram assumes charge of that Court.

### **NOTIFICATION - V.**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873) and in supersession of all previous Notifications on the subject, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby fixes the local limits of the jurisdiction of the **District Court**, **Chengalpattu and District Court**, **Kancheepuram**, comprising the Revenue Taluks, as specified in the Table below, with effect from the date on which the District Judge, Kancheepuram assumes charge of the District Court at Kancheepuram:-

# **NOTIFICATION – VI.**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 10 of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 (Central Act III of 1873) and in supersession of all previous notifications on the subject, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby fixes the local limits of the **Subordinate Judge's Courts of Chengalpattu and Kancheepuram Districts,** as specified in the Table below, with effect from the date on which the District Judge, Kancheepuram assumes charge of the District Court at Kancheepuram:-

### **NOTIFICATION – VII.**

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Central Act 2 of 1974), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby directs that **Kancheepuram Sessions Division** shall consist of the entire Revenue District of Kancheepuram with effect from the date on which the District Judge, Kancheepuram assumes charge of the Court of Sessions at Kancheepuram.

# **NOTIFICATION – VIII.**

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 7 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Central Act 2 of 1974), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after consultation with the High Court, Madras, hereby alters the limits of the Chengalpattu Sessions Division and defines the limits of the Kancheepuram Sessions Division as specified in the Table below, with effect from the date on which the Sessions Judge, Kancheepuram assumes charge of the Court of Sessions at Kancheepuram:-

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 57 of the Provincial Insolvency Act, 1920 (Central Act V of 1920), the Governor of Tamil Nadu, hereby appoints the present Official Receiver, Chengalpattu District as the Official Receiver for Kancheepuram District also until the appointment of a separate Official Receiver for Kancheepuram District.
