ORDER:

The Registrar General, High Court of Madras, in his letter read above, has stated that the High Court, after considering the request of the Keeranur Advocates Association and in consultation with the Principal District Judge, Pudukottai recommends the proposal for constitution of a Sub Court at Keeranur in Pudukottai District. In this regard, he has stated that out of 4085 cases pending on the file of the existing Principal Sub Court, Pudukottai and Additional Sub Court, Pudukottai as on 31.05.2018, 455 cases including 372 Original Suits, 61 Appeal Suits, 13 Rent Control Appeals and 9 Session Cases are arising from the territorial jurisdiction of the proposed Sub Court, Keeranur. The above number of Original Suits justify the necessity for the constitution of a Sub Court at Keeranur in Pudukottai District.

2. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras has, therefore, requested the Government to issue orders for the constitution of a Sub Court at Keeranur in Pudukottai District with requisite posts and other requirements. He has also requested the Government for the attachment of the existing posts in the Nazerath and Copyist Establishments of the District Munsif Court, Keeranur with the proposed Sub Court, Keeranur to form a Central Nazerath Establishment and Central Copyist Establishment on constitution of a Sub Court at Keeranur.

3. During the Budget Session of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for the year 2020-2021, the Hon'ble Minister for Law, Courts and Prisons, while moving the Demand for Grants relating to Administration of Justice (Demand No.3) has made, among others, the following Announcement on the Floor of the Assembly on 20.3.2020:-

"Constitution of a Sub Court at Keeranur in Pudukottai District"

4. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras, have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government order for constitution of a new Sub Court at Keeranur in Pudukottai District at a total cost of Rs.1,49,72,316/- (Rupees one crore forty nine lakh seventy two thousand three hundred and sixteen only) (i.e. Rs.1,33,75,316/- as recurring expenditure and Rs.15,97,000/- as non recurring expenditure) by sanctioning the following posts and other infrastructure facilities.

The Government also order for the attachment of the posts sanctioned to the existing Nazerath Establishment and Copyist Establishment of the District Munsif Court, Keeranur with that of the newly sanctioned Sub Court, Keeranur to form a Central Nazerath Establishment and Central Copyist Establishment on the constitution of the Sub Court at Keeranur as detailed below:-

- 6. The Director of Stationery and Printing, Chennai is directed to supply one Tamil Typewriter and one English Typewriter, stationery articles, requisite forms and registers to the above said court at free of cost against the specific indent of the Judicial officer concerned.
- 7. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is requested to send necessary draft notifications to the Government for its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, under the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 [Central Act III of 1873] for the commencement of the above said court and also to send the draft Notification under first proviso to section 13 of the said Act to be published by the High Court, for approval of the Government.
- 8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following heads of account:

- 9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New instrument of Service" and the approval of Legislature shall be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the contingency fund. The Registrar General, High Court is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period up to next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the contingency fund to the Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued by the Finance (BG-I) Department. The Registrar General, High Court is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes to the Government in the Finance (BG-I/Home-II) Department for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2020-2021 at the appropriate time without fail.
- 10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its C.No.92/Home-II/2021, dated 29.01.2021 and U.O.No.4794/CMPC/2021, dated 02.02.2021 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1577 (One thousand five hundred seventy seven).
