ORDER:-

The Registrar General, High Court of Madras, in his letter read above, has stated that the High Court, after considering the request of the Jayamkondam Bar Association and in consultation with the Principal District Judge, Ariyalur District, recommends the proposal for constitution of one more Additional District Munsif Court at Jayamkondam in Ariyalur District. In this regard, the Registrar General, High Court of Madras has stated that there were 1856 Original Suits, 323 E.Ps, 5 RCOPs and 2 other Original Petitions pending as on 31.01.2019 on the file of the existing District Munsif Court, Jayamkondam. The aforesaid pendency of cases justifies the need for the constitution of one more Additional District Munsif Court at Jayamkondam in Ariyalur District.

- 2. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras has, therefore, requested the Government to issue orders for the constitution of one more Additional District Munsif Court at Jayamkondam in Ariyalur District with requisite posts and other requirements.
- 3. During the Budget Session of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly for the year 2020-2021, the Hon'ble Minister for Law, Courts and Prisons, while moving the Demand for Grants relating to Administration of Justice (Demand No.3) has made, among others, the following Announcement on the Floor of the Assembly on 20.03.2020:-

"Constitution of one more Additional District Munsif Court at Jayamkondam in Ariyalur District" 4. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras, have decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government order for constitution of one more new Additional District Munsif Court at Jayamkondam in Ariyalur District at a total expenditure of Rs.85,30,523/- (Rupees Eighty five lakh thirty thousand five hundred and twenty three only) (i.e Rs.81,82,548/- as recurring expenditure and Rs.3,47,975/- as non-recurring expenditure) by sanctioning the following posts and other infrastructure facilities:-

- 5. The incumbents of the posts sanctioned in para-4 above are eligible to draw pay and other allowances as per orders in force.
- 6. The Director of Stationery and Printing, Chennai is directed to supply one Tamil Typewriter and one English Typewriter, stationery articles, requisite forms and registers to the above said court at free of cost against the specific indent of the Judicial officer concerned.
- 7. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is requested to send necessary draft notifications to the Government for its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, under the provisions of the Tamil Nadu Civil Courts Act, 1873 [Central Act III of 1873] for the commencement of the above said court.
- 8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited under the following heads of account:-

- 9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the contingency fund. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period up to next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the contingency fund to the Government in the Finance (BG-I/ Home-II) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued by the Finance (BG-I) Department. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2020-2021 at the appropriate time without fail.
- 10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its C.No.122/Home-II/2021, dated 22.01.2021, U.O.No.4170/CMPC/ 2021, dated 29.01.2021 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1522 (One thousand five hundred twenty two).
