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#### **ORDER**

The Registrar General, High Court of Madras, in his letters read above, has stated that the Principal District Judge, Tirunelveli has reported that 615 Civil cases and 1562 Criminal cases totally 2177 cases are pending before the District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court, Cheranmahadevi and the pendency of civil and criminal cases in District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court, Cheranmahadevi have been steadily increasing year by year. There are nine police stations coming under the jurisdiction of the District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court, Cheranmahadevi and more number of Criminal cases are filed and it is difficult for a single officer to man both civil and criminal cases in this Court, considering the increase in filing of cases. Hence, the constitution of a separate District Munsif Court and a separate Judicial Magistrate Court at Cheranmahadevi by bifurcating the existing District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court, Cheranmahadevi, will alone mitigate the problem of the litigant public as well as Advocates.

2. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary orders for constitution of a separate District Munsif Court at Cheranmahadevi with 35 posts, i.e., 27 posts by new creation and 8 posts by absorption/ redeployment and a separate Judicial Magistrate Court at Cheranmahadevi in Tirunelveli District by converting the existing District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court, Cheranmahadevi by absorption of 18 existing posts with other requirements.

3. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Registrar General, High Court of Madras, in detail have decided to accept it, subject to certain modification on staff pattern, recurring and non-recurring expenditure. Accordingly, the Government accord sanction for constitution of a separate District Munsif Court at Cheranmahadevi with 24 posts, i.e., 16 posts by new creation and 8 posts through absorption from the existing District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court, at Cheranmahadevi and Constitution of a separate Judicial Magistrate Court at Cheranmahadevi with the absorption of 18 posts from the existing District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court at Cheranmahadevi by bifurcating the existing District Munsif-cum-Judicial Magistrate Court, at Cheranmahadevi in Tirunelveli District with other requirements at a total expenditure of Rs.1,38,28,192/- (Rupees one crore thirty eight lakh twenty eight thousand one hundred and ninety two only) [viz. Rs.1,23,56,192/- as recurring expenditure and Rs.14,72,000/- as non-recurring expenditure. The Government accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.25,14,516/- (Rupees twenty five lakh fourteen thousand five hundred and sixteen only) for the year 2022-2023, as detailed in paragraph 8 below:-

- 5. The incumbents of the posts sanctioned in para 3 above are eligible for pay and other allowances as per orders in force.
- 6. The Director of Stationery and Printing, Chennai is directed to supply other stationery articles, requisite forms and registers to the above said court at free of cost against the specific indent of the Judicial officer concerned.
- 7. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras, is requested to send necessary draft notifications to the Government for its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, under relevant Legislative Acts for commencing judicial functions in the above said Courts.

- 9. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Registrar General, High Court of Madras shall also send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2022-2023 to Finance (BG-I/Home-II) Department at the appropriate time, without fail.
