ORDER:

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has made the following Announcement on the floor of Assembly during the police demand on 13.09.2021.

"சுற்றுலாத் தலங்களில் பொதுமக்களுக்குப் பாதுகாப்பும், வழிகாட்டுதலும் வழங்க சுற்றுலா காவல்துறை அமைக்கப்படும். சுற்றுலா காவல்துறையினருக்குத் தனிபயிற்சி வழங்கப்படும்".

2. Subsequent to the above announcement, the Director General of Police has sent a proposal to Government requesting formation of 7 Tourist Police Stations (i.e) (1) Marina Beach (2 Kiosks) in Chennai District, (2) Mamallapuram (3 Kiosks) in Chengalpattu District, (3) Rameshwaram (2 Kiosks) in Ramanathapuram District, (4) Kanyakumari (2 Kiosks) in Kanyakumari District, (5) Madurai (1 Kiosk) in Madurai District, (6) Kodaikanal (3 Kiosks) in Dindigul District (7) Ooty (4 Kiosks) in the Nilgiris District with staff strength of 30 police personnel per Tourist Police Station (i.e.) 2-Sub Inspectors, 2-Head Constables, 4-Grade I Police Constables and 22-Grade II Police Constables, totalling to 210 Police personnel with financial implication of Rs.15,83,49,622/- (Recurring Expenditure of Rs.13,20,56,316/- and Non-recurring Expenditure of Rs.2,62,93,306/-).

3. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Director General of Police and accord sanction for formation of 3 Tourist Police Wing at Mamallapuram (2 Kiosks) in Chengalpattu District, Kodaikanal (2 Kiosks) in Dindigul District and Ooty (2 Kiosks) in the Nilgiris District with staff strength of 9 police personnel

per Tourist Police Wing i.e (1-Sub Inspector, 1-Head Constable, 2-Grade I Police Constables & 5-Grade II Police Constables) totalling 27 (9x3) police personnel, with financial implication of Rs.2,93,09,549/- (Rupees Two crore ninety three lakh nine thousand five hundred and forty nine only) (Recurring expenditure of Rs.2,01,30,959/- + Non-recurring expenditure of Rs.91,78,590/-). These three Tourist Police Wings will be attached to the regular jurisdictional police station in which the tourist places are located and will work under the supervision of concerned Station House Officer.

4. The details of the post sanctioned are in the Annexure I to this order.

5. The details of the recurring and non-recurring expenditure are mentioned in the Annexure II to this order.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

7. The Director General of Police is directed to

- follow the purchase procedure as in force.
- co-ordinate with the Tourism Department with the functions of Tourist Police Wing and

- focus on proper selection, training & routine rotation of personnel in these posts.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course of time by an inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates, 2021-2022. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Director General of Police is requested to calculate the actual amount required for the period up to next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Director General of Police shall also send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2021-2022 to Government in Finance (BG-I/Home-I) department without fail.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.8191/Home-I/2022, dated: 23.02.2022 and ASL No.1649 (One thousand six hundred forty nine) PSL No: 202202PSL0118.
