ORDER:

In his letter second read above, the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board has stated that,

- i) The storeyed tenements constructed in Chennai and other towns in the earlier years for the urban slum families are dilapidated due to atmospheric effects, wear and tear, efflux of time and posing dangers to the lives and properties of the occupants of the tenements.
- ii) Such dilapidated tenements are inspected by a technical committee and if vulnerable recommend for demolition and reconstruction. These tenements are being reconstructed under Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP) component of Housing for All (HFA). Though the inmates of the tenements are in favour of reconstruction of dilapidated tenements, they are reluctant to vacate the tenements and move to the alternate places, due to hefty rent payable for their stay outside during the project period (approximately 24 months). The reconstruction of the dilapidated tenements could not be commenced in many places as scheduled, as the inmates of the tenements are reluctant to vacate the tenements.

- iii) In order to reduce the financial burden of the occupants of the tenements, the Government in G.O. (Ms) No.332, Housing and Urban Development Department, dated 26.10.2007, had ordered to pay Rs.8000/- per family as one time exgratia to meet the shifting and rental expenses during their stay outside the scheme area to facilitate the shifting of the families from vulnerable tenements. As the prevailing rental amount outside scheme areas are on the higher side, the proposal to increase the exgratia to Rs.24,000/- at the rate of Rs.1000/- per month for a period of two years was discussed with the Hon'ble Chief Minister during the review of the Housing and Urban Development Department on 15.07.2021 and apprised its importance and necessity.
- iv) The Hon'ble Minister for Rural Industries has also announced in the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly on 01.09.2021 that the exgratia amount payable to the occupants of the dilapidated tenements proposed for reconstruction will be increased from Rs.8,000/- to Rs.24,000/- to facilitate them to live outside the scheme area during the reconstruction period.
- v) The proposal to enhance the onetime exgratia from Rs.8000/- to Rs.24,000/- per family to facilitate the commencement of the reconstruction of dilapidated tenements was placed before the Board in its 504th meeting on 25.08.2021. The Board has approved this proposal and also resolved to pay, this amount in two instalments. ie., the first instalment of Rs.12,000/- at the time of shifting and the second instalment of Rs.12,000/- after one year. Further, it was resolved to send necessary proposal to Government for getting the In-principle Administrative sanction for the same.

2. The current status as on 30.06.2021 of the reconstruction programme of Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board is detailed below:-

3. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board has therefore requested the Government to accord In-principle

Administrative sanction to enhance the onetime exgratia from Rs.8000/- to Rs.24,000/- per family to facilitate the commencement of the reconstruction of remaining 9242 dilapidated tenements in two instalments. i.e., the first instalment of Rs.12,000/- at the time of shifting and the second instalment of Rs.12,000/- after one year.

4. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board in para 3 above. Accordingly, the Government accord In-principle Administrative sanction to enhance the onetime exgratia for the occupants of remaining 9242 dilapidated tenements of Tamil Nadu Urban Habitat Development Board from Rs.8,000/- to Rs.24,000/- per family to facilitate the commencement of the reconstruction of dilapidated tenements in two instalments i.e., the first instalment of Rs.12,000/- at the time of shifting and the second instalment of Rs.12,000/- after one year treating this as part of the project cost.

5. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.51545/Hg&UD/2021, dated 22.11.2021.
