ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued constituting a Committee of representatives of Finance Department, Highways and Minor Ports Department, Director General (H) and Concerned Chief Engineers of Highways Department for scrutiny and Review of the Revised Administrative Sanction proposals.

- 2. In the Government Order second read above, Orders have been issued according Administrative Sanction for the work of initial Rectification including Widening, Strengthening, Improvements and Performance Based Maintenance for 60 months (5 years) in 641.6 Kms of State Highways and Major District Roads in Virudhunagar District for an amount of Rs. 611.98 Crore.
- 3. In the letter 3rd read above, the Chief Engineer (H), Construction and Maintenance has stated that, the Estimate for the above work was Technically sanctioned vide office Proceeding No.0675/Salai-1/2018 Dt. 12.01.2018 for Rs.611.98 Crore and registered in Chief Engineer (H), Construction and Maintenance No.17/2017-18. Further, the tender was called and the work was entrusted to M/s S.P.K. and Co., Keelamudimannarkottai Contractor after negotiation at 5% Above Estimate Rate (2017-2018) over the value of contract put to tender Rs.581.99 Crore which works out to Rs.611.09 Crore and accepted by the Commissionerate of Tenders.

As per the accepted tender, the overall cost including the other probable costs works out to Rs.641.08 Crore which is Rs.29.10 Crore more than the administrative sanction amount of Rs.611.98 Crore due to tender premium.

4. The Committee on Revised Administrative Sanction in its meeting held on 21.11.2019 has approved the following proposal of Chief Engineer (H), Construction and Maintenance

The Chief Engineer (H), Construction and Maintenance has therefore requested orders of the Government to accord Revised Administrative Sanction for the work of "Initial Rectification (Widening, Strengthening, Improvements, CD Works) Minor Improvements (Widening, Strengthening, Improvements, CD Works) and Comprehensive Maintenance Through Performance Based Maintenance Contract for 5 Years in State Highways and Major District Roads in Virudhunagar (H) Construction and Maintenance Division" for an amount of Rs.641.08 Crore as recommended by Revised Administrative Sanction Committee.
- 6. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (H), Construction and Maintenance as recommended by revised Administrative Sanction Committee and accord Revised Administrative Sanction for the work of "Initial Rectification (Widening, Strengthening, Improvements, CD Works) Minor Improvements (Widening, Strengthening, Improvements, CD Works) and Comprehensive Maintenance through Performance Based Maintenance Contract for and Maintenance Division". for an amount of Rs.641,08,00,000/- (Rupees Six Hundred Rs.611,98,00,000/-.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 shall be met from the existing budget provision under the following Head of Account:

5054-Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges-03 State Highways-337 Road Works-State's Expenditure-JN Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme (CRIDP) - Performance Based maintenance Contract-416 Major Works-01.Major Works.
