



## Abstract

Highways and Minor Ports Department – Roads and Bridges – Widening and Improvement of State Highways, Major District Roads, Other District Roads and Construction of Bridges under Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme for the year 2014-15 – Administrative Sanction- Accorded – Orders-Issued.

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### ORDER:-

In the letter first read above, the Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance), Highways Department has sent proposals to take up new works to the tune of Rs.5400.00 crore under Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme (CRIDP), for the year 2014-15.

2. In the letter second read above, the Government directed the Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance), Highways Department to send the revised proposal under Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme for the year 2014-15 to Rs.3000.00 crore.

3. In the letter third read above, the Chief Engineer Construction & Maintenance), Highways Department has sent the revised proposals giving importance for widening of State Highways from Intermediate Lane to Double Lane and Major District Roads from Single Lane to Intermediate Lane and widening and strengthening of Other District Roads, bridges, culverts etc, and also considering the announcement made by Hon'ble Chief Minister under Rule 110 in the floor of Assembly, announcements made by the Minister (Finance & Public Works) in the budget speech and the announcements of Minister (Highways and Minor Ports) while moving the demand for Highways and Minor Ports Department,

at a total cost of Rs.3000.00 crore under Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme for the year 2014-15 as detailed below:

4. The Government have examined the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance), Highways Department in detail and decided to accept the same. Administrative Sanction is hereby accorded for widening and improvement of State Highways, Major District Roads, Other District Roads and bridges, culverts, etc. at a total cost of Rs.3000.00 crore (Rupees Three Thousand crore only) for 2139 No. of works under the Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme for the year 2014-15 as per outlay indicated in Para 3 above. The details of the works are annexed to this order.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in Para 4 above shall be debited to the following heads of account:-

(i) State Highways – Rs.1186.55 crore (Rupees One Thousand One Hundred and Eighty Six crore and Fifty Five lakh only) for 712 No. of works:-

5054 – Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 03- State Highways – 337 – Road Works – Schemes in the Twelfth Five year Plan-II-State Plan-JI-Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme – State Highways – 16. Major works (DP Code 5054-03-337-JI-1602)

(ii) Major District Roads – Rs.735.32 crore (Rupees Seven Hundred and Thirty Five crore and Thirty Two lakh only) for 434 No. of works:-

5054 - Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 04 -District and Other Roads – 337- Road Works – Schemes in the Twelfth Five year Plan-II -State Plan –JT-Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme – Major District Roads – 16. Major works (DP Code 5054-04-337-JT-1609)

(iii) Other District Roads – Rs.884.39 crore (Rupees Eight Hundred and Eighty Four crore and Thirty Nine lakh only) for 803 No. of works:-

5054 - Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 04- District and Other Roads- 337- Road Works – Schemes in the Twelfth Five year Plan-II-State Plan –JU-Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme – Other District Roads – 16 Major works. (DP Code 5054-04-337-JU-1607)

(iv) Special Component Plan (Other District Roads) – Rs.193.74 crore (Rupees One Hundred and Ninety Three crore and Seventy Four lakh only) for 190 No. of works:-

5054 - Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 04 - District and Other Roads – 789 – Special Component Plan for Scheduled Castes – Schemes in the Twelfth Five year Plan-II-State Plan- JC Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme – Other District Roads Under Special Component Plan – 16 Major works. (DP Code 5054-04-789-JC-1606)

6. The Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance), Highways Department, is directed to take up the works early and furnish monthly progress report to Government. He is also requested to ensure that the works sanctioned now are not included in any other schemes and have not been taken previously.

7. The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department is also directed to initiate land acquisition process even for works which do not specifically mention land acquisition in the nomenclature works

8. The Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance), Highways Department is also authorized to make changes in the nomenclature of works or delete / substitute works without exceeding the total cost of the work, subject to obtaining prior approval of the Government in Highways and Minor Ports Department.
