



## **ABSTRACT**

Highways and Minor Ports Department – Construction and Maintenance Wing – Land Acquisition at Km 1/7 of Tambaram – Mudichur – Sriperumbudhur road (SH 110) - Revised Administrative Sanction – Orders – Issued.

### **ORDER:**

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued for constituting a Committee consisting of representatives of Finance Department, Highways and Minor Ports Department, Director General and Concerned Chief Engineers' of Highways Department for scrutiny and Review of the Revised Administrative Sanction proposals.

2. In the Government Order second read above. Government have accorded Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.10.00 lakh for the work "Land Acquisition at Km 1/7 of Tambaram – Mudichur – Sriperumbudhur road (SH 110)".

3. The Chief Engineer (H), Construction and Maintenance has informed that Tambaram – Mudichur – Sriperumbudhur road is an important State Highways road (SH 110). This road branches at km 26/0 right side of GST road (NH 45) and ends at Sriperumbudhur. The stretch at km 1/7 is a four legged intersection located below the Tambaram – Maduravoyal underpass. The Storm water dam has not been connected to a length of 30m that causes stagnation of water on the riding surface. Hence, it is essential to acquire land to an extent of 88 Sq.m.

4. The Chief Engineer (H), Construction and Maintenance has also informed that the Special Tahsildhar (LA), Inner ring road project, Chrompet has sent the demand for

an amount of Rs.1,15,01,404/- as compensation up to 22.04.2021. Incorporating the above provisions, the total cost of LA, works out to **Rs.115.15 lakhs** including Advertisement Charges and Petty Supervision & Contingencies charges. Hence the Revised Administrative sanction proposal for "Land Acquisition at Km 1/7 of Tambaram – Mudichur – Sriperumbudhur road (SH 110)" for an amount of Rs.115.15 lakhs was placed before RAS committee at Government level and the same was approved on 22.09.2021.

5. The Chief Engineer (H), Construction and Maintenance has reported that the Revised Administrative Sanction (RAS) for the above work was placed before the "Committee on RAS" held on 22.09.2021. The RAS Committee has recommended the RAS proposal for Rs.115.15 lakh.

6. The Chief Engineer (H), Construction and Maintenance has requested orders of the Government to accord Revised Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.115.15 lakh for the work of "Land Acquisition at Km 1/7 of Tambaram – Mudichur – Sriperumbudhur road (SH 110)" as recommended by Revised Administrative Sanction Committee.

7. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (H), Construction and Maintenance and accord Revised Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.1,15,15,000/- (Rupees One crore fifteen lakh and fifteen thousand only) against the Administrative Sanction amount of Rs.10,00,000/- for the work of Land Acquisition at Km 1/7 of Tambaram – Mudichur – Sriperumbudhur road (SH 110). Subject to the following conditions specified below:

- i. The additional expenditure (i.e., RAS of Rs.1,15,00,000/- – AS of Rs.10,00,000/- = Rs.1,05,15,000/-) should be met within the existing budget provision.
- ii. The award should be passed within two months after issuing the G.O. and the amount should be settled within one month from date of passing the award.
- iii. Thus, the LAO can settle the amount sanctioned in G.O., plus the interest upto settlement of amount as indicated at (ii) above without coming for RAS again for interest amount.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para-7, above shall be debited to the following Head of account:

5054-Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 03 State Highways – 337 Road Works – State's Expenditure – JI - Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme (CRIDP) - State Highways - 416 Major Works - 01.Major Works.

9. The Chief Engineer (H), Construction and Maintenance is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para-7 above.
