Letter from the Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department, Letter No.2136/W2/2022, dated 27.04.2022.

ORDER:-

During the budget session on 12.04.2022 the Hon'ble Minister for Public Works, Highways and Minor Ports has announced the following.

"ஈரோடு மாவட்டம் பாசூர் மற்றும் விழுப்புரம் மாவட்டம் கூட்டேரிபட்டு இரயில்வே கடவுகளுக்கு மாற்றாக இரயில்வே மேம்பாலம் கட்ட, முதற்கட்டமாக ரூ.86 இலட்சம் மதிப்பீட்டில் விரிவான திட்ட அறிக்கை தயாரிக்கப்படும்."

In the letter read above, the Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways 2. Department has stated that this road connects Kumarapalayam - Pallipalayam -Jedarpalayam - Pandamangalam- Velur road (SH-198) and Erode-Karur road (SH-84). This road forms a part of Pasur Railway Station - Vellode road which serves the public for transport from Salem, Namakkal, Erode and Karur District. The proposed Rail Over Bridge is located at Km 0/2 of Pasur Railway Station - Vellode road (MD-885). It is classified as Major District Road, On the other side of the Level Crossing there is Town panchayat road which leads to Pasur - Solasiramani Barriage and ends at Komarapalayam - Pallipalayam - Jedarpalayam -Pandamangalam - Velur road. The road was mostly used by the Namakkal, Salem and Erode district people since it reduces the distance of nearly 30 kms to Velur from Erode. This road passes through an area having plenty of agriculture activities and banana plantation on either side of the road. For transportation of these agricultural goods to Erode, this road serves as a key factor. Lot of Commercial shops, Banks and Residential buildings are located in this areas. Due to frequent closure of level crossing acute and perennial traffic problem has been experienced. It is a long standing demand of the General public of this area to construct a flyover bypassing the level crossing. The Train Vehicle Unit of the Level Crossing is 126762 as per 15/09/2018. This work has been proposed by Railway Works Programme of the year 2022-23 (UMB item 359 of WP 2022-23). The right of way of the Pasur Railway Station Vellode road in the proposed Road Over Bridge portion is around 10.00 m (Avg). Hence, Land has to be acquired for the proposed construction. The carriage way width of Major District Road is 7.00 m and the carriage way width of Panchayat Unit road is 3.75 m. Construction of the Proposed Road Over Bridge, will avert frequent traffic jams and accidents at Level Crossings.

- 3. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department has therefore requested the Government to accord administrative sanction for the preparation of Detailed Project Report for the work of "Construction of Road Over Bridge at km 0/2 of Pasur Railway Staition Vellode road (MD-885) in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.16 at Railway Km 19/000-100 in between Pasur and Kodumudi Railway Stations" for Rs.50,00,000/-.
- 4. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department and accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.50,00,000/- (Rupees Fifty lakh only) for the preparation of Detailed Project Report for the work of "Construction of Road Over Bridge at km 0/2 of Pasur Railway Station Vellode road (MD-885) in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.16 at Railway Km 19/000-100 in between Pasur and Kodumudi Railway Stations".
- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in para-4 above shall be debited to the following head of account.

"5054 - Capital outlay on Roads and Bridges — 80. General — 004. Research and Development — State's Expenditure — AA Investigation / Estimation of project work under Roads & Bridges — 416 Major works — 01. Major works."

- 6. The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para-4 above.
- 7. The expenditure sanctioned in Para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department is also directed to send a draft explanatory notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023 to Finance (B.G-I / PW-I) Department without fail.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O. No.32322/PW1/P/2022, dated 31.06.2022 and Additional Sanctioned Ledger No.0535 (Five Hundred and Thirty Five), (IFHRMS ASL No.2022060535).
