ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued constituting a Committee consisting representatives of Finance Department, Highways and Minor Ports Department, Director General and concerned Chief Engineers of Highways Department for scrutiny and review of the Revised Administrative Sanction proposals.

2. The Committee on Revised Administrative Sanction in its meeting held on 28.11.2019, approved the following proposals of Chief Engineer (Highways) NABARD and Rural Roads:

3. Based on the recommendation of Revised Administrative Sanction Committee, the Chief Engineer (Highways) NABARD and Rural Roads in his letter second read above has requested the Government to accord Revised Administrative Sanction for the above 2 works for an amount of Rs.995.00 Lakhs.

4. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Highways) NABARD and Rural Roads and accord Revised Administrative Sanction for the following 2 works for an amount of Rs.9,95,00,000/- (Rupees Nine Crore and Ninety Five Lakhs only) as recommended by the Revised Administrative Sanction Committee against the Administrative/Technical Sanctioned amount of Rs.7,70,00,000/- and accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.1,00,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore only) during year 2020-2021. The balance amount will be released based on the requirements.

5. The expenditure sanctioned at para 4 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

6. The Chief Engineer (Highways) NABARD and Rural Roads is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in Para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Highways) NABARD and Rural Roads is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy this order. Orders for sanction for and advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Highways) NABARD and Rural Roads is also directed to send a draft explanatory notes for inclusion the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2020-2021 to Finance (BG-I/PW-I) Department without fail.
