## ORDER:-

During the Budget Session 2021-2022 on 27.08.2021 among others, the Hon'ble Minister for Public Works has announced that Preparation of Detailed Project Report will be taken up for "Construction of Bypasses to 15 towns" as below:

``போக்குவரத்து நெரிசலை குறைக்கவும், சாலை பாதுகாப்பிணை மேம்படுத்தவும் நடப்பாண்டில் அறந்தாங்கி, திருச்சி (அரைவட்டசாலை), ஆலங்குடி, மயிலாடுதுறை, முசிறி, வெள்ளக்கோவில், திருப்பூர், காங்கேயம், பென்னாடம், செந்துறை, செங்கம், மேல்கச்சிராப்பட்டு, புதுவயல், தருமபுரி கெங்கவல்லி ஆகிய நகரங்களுக்கு புறவழிச்சாலை அமைக்க விரிவான திட்ட அறிக்கை ரூ.9.83 கோடி மதிப்பில் தயாரிக்கப்படும்".

- 2. Based on the above, announcement, the Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance in the letter read above has furnished the proposal along with estimates at a cost of Rs.828.50 Lakh for Preparation of Detailed Project Report for Construction of Bypasses to 13 towns viz. Aranthangi, Trichy (Half Ring Road), Alangudi, Mayiladuthurai, Musiri, Vellakovil, Tiruppur, Kangeyam, Pennadam, Sendurai, Chengam, Melkachirapattu-Kelkachikrapattu and Puduvoyal.
- 3. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance has therefore requested orders of the Government to accord Administrative Sanction for Preparation of Detailed Project Report for the Construction of 13 Bypasses in 8 Districts for a sum of Rs.828.50 Lakh.

4. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance and accord Administrative Sanction for a sum of Rs.828.50 Lakh (Rupees Eight Crore Twenty Eight Lakh and Fifty Thousand only) for Preparation of Detailed Project Report for the work of Construction of Bypasses to 13 Towns in 8 Districts as detailed below and accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.331.40 Lakh in the current financial year 2021-2022. The balance amount will be released based on the requirement.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

5054 – Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 80 General – 004. Research and Development – State's Expenditure–AA. Investigation / Estimation of Project Work under Roads and Bridges – 416. Major Works – 01 – Major Works.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para-4 above is an item of "New Instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance, Chennai is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-I) Department. He is also directed to

send a draft explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2021-22 to Finance (BG-I) /(PW-I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

- 7. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above.
- 8. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.52268/PW-I/2021, dated 07.12.2021 and Additional Sanction Ledger No. 1086 (One Thousand and Eight Six).
