- 3. In his letter third read above, the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project-II has stated that, the entire expenditure including course fee which will include full tuition cost, related program materials, accommodation in Melbourne, welcome reception, lunches, refreshments, course dinner and air ticket booking with travel & medical insurances will be borne by Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project, phase –II. All arrangements (Air ticket, VISA, Travel & Medical insurance and Local Transport in Australia) for Thiru. C.Samayamoorthy, I.A.S, Transport Commissioner to attend the MUARC Road Safety Management Leadership Program—May 2018 has been processed by the Highways Department through Travel agent and the actual expenses for the above training program is Rs.10,07,830/- as against the

earlier sanction of Rs.9,50,000/- towards the cost of above mentioned training program and requested the Government to sanction the revised amount of Rs.10,07,830/- utilised from the funds available under Road Safety Component of Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project-II for the above said training.
