ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for carrying out Land Acquisition for an amount of Rs.174.00 Lakh for the work of “Construction of Road Over Bridge at km 0/2 of Lakshmi Ammalpuram to Navithampatti road in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.72 at Railway km 168/12-14 in between Melpatti and Valathur Railway stations”.

2. The Revised Administrative Committee, in its meeting held on 01.12.2020, has recommended the following proposal of the Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department.

3. In the letter second read above, the Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department has requested the Government to accord Revised Administrative Sanction for carrying out Land Acquisition for the work of “Construction of Road Over Bridge at km 0/2 of Lakshmi Ammalpuram to Navithampatti road in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.72 at Railway km 168/12-14 in between Melpatti and Valathur Railway stations” for an amount of Rs.4,30,00,000/- as recommended by the Revised Administrative Sanction committee.

4. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department and to accord Revised Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.3,32,84,174/- (Rupees Three crore thirty two lakh eighty four thousand one hundred and seventy four only) for carrying out Land Acquisition for the work of “Construction of Road Over Bridge at km 0/2 of Lakshmi Ammalpuram to Navithampatti road in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.72 at Railway km 168/12-14 in between Melpatti and Valathur Railway stations”, as against the Administrative Sanction amount of Rs.1,74,00,000/- and accord Financial Sanction for a sum of Rs.1,58,84,174/- (Rupees One crore fifty eight lakh eighty four thousand one hundred and seventy four only).

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited under the following head of account:-

“5054 – Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 03. State Highways – 101. Bridges – State’s Expenditure – JG. Construction of over and under bridges in lieu of Existing Level Crossings – 464. Lands – 01.Lands”

6. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of “New Instrument of Service” and approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course.

Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department is also directed to send a draft explanatory notes for inclusion the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2021-2022 to Finance (BG-I) Department without fail.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O. No.48955/PW1/2021, dated 17.12.2021 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1176 (One thousand one hundred and seventy six).
