ORDER:

During the Budget Session 2019-2020, former Chief Minister has announced that "Reconstruction of High Level Bridge at Km 4/2 of Peramangalam - Keelavadi road (Other District Roads) across Uppar river will be taken up".

- 2. Based on the above announcement in Government Order first read above, orders have been issued according Administrative Sanction for the preparation of Detailed Project Report for "Reconstruction of High Level Bridge at Km 4/2 of Peramangalam Keelavadi road (Other District Roads) across Uppar river" for an amount of Rs.4.53 Lakh.
- 3. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Projects in his letter second read above has stated that, the proposed bridge is located at km 4/2 of Peramangalam-Keelavadi road (Other District Roads), which branches at km 14/6 of SH -62 (Trichy Thuraiyur road) in Trichy District. This is an important Other District Road maintained by Trichy (Highways), Construction & Maintenance division. The existing causeway is a 3 row 600mm dia piped causeway with total length of 110 m and width of 7.50 m. This existing piped causeway is in damaged condition and hence reconstruction of this causeway is necessary. The water course is a non-perennial river (Rain fed river). As per the policy of the State Government, the causeways on important Other District Roads will be replaced with High Level Bridges. During rainy season, the traffic will be

cutoff for 5 to 7 days, until the flood water recedes. Due to interruption of traffic, agricultural products could not be transported to markets in time, which results in huge financial loss to the farmers, and also causes inconvenience to the school and college going children. More than 20,000 people residing in Peramangalam, Omandur, Thinnanur & Abinimangalam villages will be benefitted.

- 4. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Projects has further stated that, the alignment starts at Km 3/808 of Peramangalam–Keelavadi road (Other District Roads) and ends at Km 4/187 of the same road with a length of 378.60 m. The proposed alignment crosses the Uppar river between Ch.250.124 and ch.301.029 at 13 degree skew. The alignment has been approved by Alignment Committee on 22.02.2020. Based on the approved drawings and quantity estimate received from Chief Engineer (Highways) Planning Designs and Investigation, the rough cost estimate for the above work has been prepared for an amount of Rs.3.73 Crore adopting the current Schedule of Rates 2021-22 including a provision of 8% for Schedule of Rates 2022-2023.
- 5. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Projects has therefore requested orders of the Government to accord Administrative Sanction for the work of "Reconstruction of High Level Bridge at Km 4/2 of Peramangalam Keelavadi road (Other District Roads) across Uppar River" for an amount of Rs.3,73,00,000/- (Rupees Three Crore and Seventy Three Lakh only).
- 6. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of Chief Engineer (Highways) Projects, hereby accord Administrative Sanction for a sum of Rs.3,35,00,000/- (Rupees Three Crore and Thirty Five Lakh only) for the work of "Reconstruction of High Level Bridge at Km 4/2 of Peramangalam Keelavadi road (Other District Roads) across Uppar River" under Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme Bank of sanction for the year 2022-2023.
- 7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following Head of account:-
 - 5054 Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges
 - 04 District and other Roads
 - 337 Road Works
 State's Expenditure
 - JU Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme (CRIDP) – Other District Roads
 - 416 Major Works 01. Major Works (IFHRMS CODE :5054 04 337 JU 41601)
- 8. This Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above.
