Highways Department – Projects wing – Coimbatore Circle – Salem Division – Railway Works Programme 2014-15 - Construction of Road Over Bridge at Km 24/8 of Salem – Ulundurpet Road in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.159 at Railway Km 164/600-700 in between Valappady and Minnampalli Railway Stations in Salem District – Administrative and Financial Sanction – Accorded – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above, among others, Administrative Sanction was accorded for an amount of Rs.699.20 lakh towards Preliminary charges for carrying out the Land Acquisition, Shifting of Service utilities and Investigation works.

2. In the letter second read above, the Chief Engineer (Projects) stated that the existing Level Crossing No.159 is located in between Valappady and Minnampalli Railway Stations at Railway Km.164/600-700. The railway track crosses the road at Km.24/8 of Salem Ulundurpet Road, which is classified as (old National Highways-68) an abandoned National Highways, under the administrative control of National Highways Authority of India. The Salem - Ulundurpet Road (old National Highways - 68) branches at Km.27/4 of National Highways - 79 and again joins at Km.32/4 of the National Highways - 79. Necessary approval and no objection certificate has been given by National Highways Authority of India for the construction of the Road Over Bridge. The Road Over Bridge is proposed in Valapady Town Panchayat under Yercaud Assembly Constituency and Kallakurichi Parliamentary Constituency. The Alignment for the above Road Over Bridge work has been approved by the alignment committee on 02.06.2016. The approved Railway General Arrangement Drawing has also been received from Southern Railways. The alignment starts at km 24/341 of existing Salem - Ulundurpet Road (old National Highways - 68) and crosses the Railway boundary from Ch.473.01 to Ch.511.71 at a skew angle of 55 degree and ends at Ch.1031.000 at km 25/352 of Salem - Ulundurpet Road. This Road (Old National Highways - 68) connects Valappady, Attur, Thimmanaickenpatty, Mollaikarai, Thammanpatty, Mangalapuram

and Rasipuram. As on 2017, Train Vehicle Unit of 126480 has been observed at Level Crossing No159. Non - Standard curves are present at both sides of the Level Crossing, which leads to accidents at this location. Also, Traffic jam occurs frequently due to closure of Level Crossing for passing of trains. To regulate the heavy vehicular traffic and to avoid the traffic jam and time delay at Level Crossing No.159, it is very essential to provide a Road Over Bridge in lieu of level crossing. The work has been included in Railway Work Programme 2014-15 (Sponsored by Railways for 50:50 cost sharing).The alignment for the above Road Over Bridge work has been approved by the alignment committee originally on 6.02.2014. After approval of revised Alignment, Land Plan Schedule has been revised and submitted for acquiring an extent of 4970 sqm private land. The 15(2), 15(1) Notification and Government Gazette Notification have been completed and Final Award enquiry has been conducted by the Competent Authority for Land Acquisition on 09.12.2020 for which the final Award has to be pronounced by Revenue Department.

3. The Chief Engineer, Projects, has therefore requested the Government to accord Administrative Sanction for the work of "Construction of Road Over Bridge at Km 24/8 of Salem – Ulundurpet Road in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.159 at Railway Km 164/600-700 in between Valappady and Minnampalli Railway Stations", for an amount of Rs.34,03,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Four Crore and Three Lakh only) prepared as per Schedule of Rate 2021-2022.

4. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department and accord administrative sanction at a cost of Rs.29,44,00,183/-(Rupees Twenty Nine Crore Fourty Four lakh and one hundred and eighty three only) and accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakh Only) for the current financial year 2022-2023 as detailed below

6. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department, is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para-4 above.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para - 4 above is an item of "New Instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawl of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways

Department is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-I) Department. He is also directed to send a draft explanatory note for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023 to Finance (BG-I/ PW-I) Department without fail.
