ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued constituting a Committee consisting of representatives of Finance Department, Highways and Minor Ports Department, Director General and concerned Chief Engineers of Highways Department for scrutiny of Revised Administrative Sanction proposals.

- 2) In the Government Order second read above, orders were issued sanctioning an amount of Rs.400.00 lakhs for Land acquisition for formation of Illupur bypass.
- 3) In the Government Order third read above, orders were issued sanctioning 1st Revised Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.1944.00 lakhs.
- 4) The Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance) in her letter 4th cited, has stated that the total compensation for the land acquisition for the above work in three villages (Illupur, Idayapatti and Enai) works out to an amount of Rs.33,46,09,118/-. Incorporating the above provisions, the total cost of LA including advertisement charges, DPR, P.S and Contingencies works out to Rs.3409.00 lakhs for total land extent of 157343 sqm. Hence, the Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance) has requested 2nd Revised Administrative for Rs.3409.00 lakhs as tabulated below:-

- 6) The Committee on RAS in its meeting held on 27.08.2018 approved the Revised Administrative Sanction proposal relating to land acquisition for formation of Illuppur Bypass for Rs.34.09 crore.
- 7) The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Construction & Maintenance) Highways Department and accord 2nd Revised Administrative Sanction amounting to Rs.34,09,03,889/- (Rupees Thirty Four crores Nine lakhs three thousand eight hundred and eighty nine only) as recommended by the Revised Administrative Sanction Committee as against the first Revised Administrative Sanction amount of Rs.1944.00 lakhs for land acquisition for formation of Illupur bypass and financial sanction of Rs.14,65,04,000/- for the year 2018-19.
- 8) The expenditure sanctioned in para-7 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"5054 - Capital outlay on Roads and Bridges - 03 - State Highways - 337 Road Works - State's expenditure JI - Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme (CRIDP) - State Highways - 16 - Major Works" (D.P.Code 5054-03-337-JI-1602)

- 9) The expenditure sanctioned in Para-7 above is an item of "New Instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance) Highways Department is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-I) Department. He is also directed to send a draft explanatory notes for inclusion the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2018-19 to Finance (BG-I/PW-I) Department without fail.
