ORDER:

In the Government order second read above, orders were issued for according Administrative Sanction for "Land Acquisition for forming Ring Road to Mannargudi town branching and merging at Km 35/2 of Kumbakonam-Mannargudi-Adhirampattinam Road (Highways-66)" for an amount of Rs.10.06 Crore.

2. The Committee on Revised Administrative Sanction constituted in the Government order first read above in its meeting held on 29.10.2021, approved the following proposal of Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance:

The Chief Engineer (H) Construction and Maintenance has therefore requested orders of the Government to accord Revised Administrative Sanction for "Land Acquisition for Forming Ring Road to Mannargudi town branching and merging at Km 35/2 of Kumbakonam-Mannargudi-Adhirampattinam Road (Highways-66)" for an amount of Rs.36,37,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Six Crore and Thirty Seven Lakh only) as recommended by the Revised Administrative Sanction Committee.

4. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance as recommended by Revised Administrative Sanction Committee hereby accord sanction for an amount of Rs.36,37,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Six Crore and Thirty Seven Lakh only) for "Land Acquisition for Forming Ring road to Mannargudi town branching and merging at Km 35/2 of Kumbakonam-Mannargudi-Adhirampattinam Road (SH 66)" as against the Administrative Sanction amount of Rs.10.06 Crore and accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.26,31,00,000 (Rupees Twenty Six Crore and Thirty One Lakh only) in the current financial year 2022-2023.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

5054 - Capital outlay on Roads and Bridges-04. District and Other Roads -800 - Other Expenditure State's Expenditure JK - Acquisition of Lands for Bypasses - 464 Lands. 01-Lands.

6. Necessary funds of Rs.26,31,00,000/-will be provided in Final Modified Appropriation 2022-2023 to meet the expenditure sanction in para 4 above. Pending provision of such funds, the Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance, is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned above. This expenditure should be brought to the

notice of the Legislative Assembly by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance, is directed to include the expenditure while sending the budget proposal for Final Modified Appropriation 2022-2023 and also send the draft explanatory notes for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023 to Government in Finance (B.G-I/PW-I) Department, without fail.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.7319/PW-1/2023, dated 11.03.2023 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.2621 (Two Thousand Six Hundred and Twenty One) (IFHRMS Additional Sanction Ledger No.2023032621).
