#### **ORDER:**

In the Government Order 1<sup>st</sup> read above, orders were issued to constitute an Expert Committee on Road Safety, District Level Monitoring Committee and Road Safety Cell Engineering in the Office of the Chief Engineer (National Highways), Highways Department for implementation of Road Safety Works in the State of Tamil Nadu:

2. In the Government Order 1<sup>st</sup> read above, Expert Committee for recommendation of road safety engineering proposal under Central Road Fund has been constituted as follows.

#### **(I) The Expert Committee:**

This Committee shall be constituted by the Chief Secretary

- (1) The committee shall be headed by  
The Chief Engineer (H), Construction and Maintenance with  
The Chief Engineer (Road Safety), Ministry of Road Transport & Highways,  
Government of India (or) his representative



(2) The ex-officio Members are:-

- i. The Regional officer, Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India.
- ii. The Chief Engineer (National Highways), Highways Department.
- iii. Representative of state nodal authority for road safety

(3) Not more than 3 experts in Road safety from academicians of the IITs, NITs / Engineering Colleges in the State (or) Other experts working in the area of road safety engineering. (to be selected by Chief Secretary of the State would be other members).

(The proposal recommended by the committee shall be sanctioned by the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways).

2. As ordered in the Government Order read above, the Chief Secretary has to nominate not more than 3 experts as other members in Road safety from academicians of the IITs, NITs / Engineering Colleges in the State (or) Other experts working in the area of road safety engineering.

3. In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Chief Engineer (National Highways), Highways Department has suggested 9 experts / academicians working in the area of road safety engineering for selecting them for nominating as other members in the expert committee.

4. The Government, after careful and detailed examination, has decided to nominate the following experts / academicians to the expert committee as other members for recommendation of road safety engineering proposal under Revamped Central Road Fund scheme and issue orders accordingly:-

1. Dr. A. Veera Raghavan, Professor, IIT, Chennai.
2. Dr. S. Moses Santhakumar, Professor, NIT, Trichy.
3. Dr. K. Gunasekaran, Associate Professor, College of Engineering, Guindy, Chennai.
