



## **ABSTRACT**

Tamil Nadu Maritime Board – Modification of Port dues and name of the Port – Amendment - Issued.

### **ORDER:-**

In the Government Orders first read above, orders were issued revising the scale of rates and fixing of rates for container in minor ports and also ordered that the concessional rate will commence from the date of commissioning of the first port eligible for concession or in the year 2011, whichever is earlier.

2. In the Government Order 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, orders have been issued declaring Panaiyur Port as a Minor Port. In the above Government Order in Notification-V, the provisions of the Indian Ports Act, 1908 has been extended and the Rate of Port dues has been mentioned at the old rates.

3. In the Government Order third read above, orders have been issued modifying the port limits of Silambimangalam Port and changing the name of the Port as "Silambimangalam Port" instead of "Silambimangalam Shipyard Port". In this Government Order, the Notification – V (Port Dues) was not included as it was not in the earlier G.O.(MS)No.183, Highways (HN2) Department, dated 23.07.2007.

4. In the letters fourth read above, the Additional Chief Secretary / Vice Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Maritime Board, has revised the scales of rates with effect from 01.04.2017 and the present Port Dues rates are Rs. Ten and Paise Forty only for Foreign / Coastal Vessels and Rs. Eight and Paise Sixty five only per ton on Gross Registered Tonnage for Sailing Vessels and requested the Government to issue amendment orders to the Government Order 2<sup>nd</sup> read above by incorporating the



present rate of port dues in the Notification – V and modify the port name “Silambimangalam Shipyard” as Silambimangalam. Further, in the Government Order, 4<sup>th</sup> read above, orders were issued Denotifying the Valinokkam and Punnakayal.

5. The Government have examined the proposal of the Additional Chief Secretary / Vice Chairman and Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Maritime Board and decided to accept it. Accordingly under subsection (2) of section 33 of the Indian Ports Act, 1908; (Central Act XV of 1908), the Government have decided to amend the first schedule to the Indian Ports Act, 1908 (Central Act XV of 1908) based on the orders issued in Government Orders 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> read above.

6. The Notification appended to this order will be published in an extraordinary issue of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette and in the Cuddalore District Gazette.

7. The Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai is requested to send 50 copies of Notification on publication to Government.

### NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub - section (2) of section 33 of the Indian Ports Act, 1908 (Central Act XV of 1908), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the First Schedule to the said Act.

### AMENDMENT.
