

## **ABSTRACT**

ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued constituting a Committee consisting of representatives of Finance Department, Highways and Minor Ports Department, Director General and concerned Chief Engineers' of Highways Department for scrutiny and review of the Revised Administrative Sanction proposals.

- 2. In the Government Order second read above Administrative Sanction was accorded for Land Acquisition for the work of "Formation of Tiruvarur Byepass" for an amount of Rs.10.10 Crore.
- 3. In the Government Order third read above Revised Administrative Sanction-I was accorded "Land Acquisition for the Formation of Byepass to Tiruvarur Town" for an amount of Rs.47.00 Crore due to increased Land value and including provision for 100% Solatium, 30% Rehabilitation and Resettlement, 12% for Additional market value, Advertisement Charges and Provision for Petty Supervision and Contingencies Charges.
- 4. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance in the letter fourth read above has stated that, the length of Tiruvarur Bypass is 9.98 km and the

Land Acquisition for the formation of above work involves 11 villages. The extents required for formation of bypass to Tiruvarur town are (1) Government Land-3.90.76 Hectares (2) HR&CE Land-2.26.70 Hectares and (3) Private Patta Land-37.53.46 Hectares. However, the District Revenue Officer has furnished the Land value including Solatium, 12% for Additional market value and the interest on land value from the date of taken over possession to the date of final award passed (Assumed date of final award latest by 31.12.2020 for the villages for which final award to be passed) as Rs.70,23,20,203/- for the acquired Patta Land of 37.53.46 Hectare from 11 villages and the Land Value for HR&CE lands of 2.26.70 Hectare as Rs.30,76,836. Provisions made in the RAS proposal for variation of 9% and 15% interests on land value at the time of passing award. Incorporating the above provisions, the total cost of Land Acquisition including land cost, lumpsum provisions, advertisement charges and Petty Supervision Contingencies works out to Rs.72.10 Crore was placed before the Revised Administrative Sanction Committee on 11.09.2020 and the same was recommended by the Committee.

- 5. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance has therefore requested orders of the Government to accord the 2<sup>nd</sup> Revised Administrative Sanction for the Land Acquisition for the work of "Formation of Bypass to Tiruvarur Town" for an amount of Rs.72.10 Crore based on the recommendation of Revised Administrative Sanction Committee.
- 6. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance as recommended by Revised Administrative Sanction Committee and accord 2<sup>nd</sup> Revised Administrative Sanction for the Land Acquisition for the work of "Formation of Byepass to Tiruvarur Town" for an amount of Rs.72,10,00,000/- (Rupees Seventy Two Crore and Ten Lakh only) against the 1st Revised Administrative Sanction amount of Rs.47,00,00,000/-.
- 7. The expenditure sanctioned in para-6 above shall be debited to the following Head of account:-

"5054. Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges - 04.
District and other Roads - 800 - Other Expenditure State's Expenditure-JK - Acquisition of lands for Byepasses"- 464. Lands. 01.Lands - Voted.

- 8. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above.
- 9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance is also

appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance is also directed to send a draft explanatory notes for inclusion the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2020-2021 to Finance (PW-I/BG-I) Department without fail.
