



ABSTRACT

Highways Department – Projects wing – Madurai circle – Madurai Division – Administrative Sanction for the work of “Construction of ROB at Km 0/2-4 of Thirumangalam Municipality road in lieu of existing LC No. 377 at Railway km 512/400-500 in between Thirumangalam and Kallikudi Railway Stations”, for an amount of Rs.30,43,82,289/- – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued according administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.39.01 Lakhs for preparation of Detailed Project Report for “Construction of ROB at Km 0/2-4 of Thirumangalam Municipality road in lieu of existing LC No. 377 at Railway km 512/400-500 in between Thirumangalam and Kallikudi Railway Stations”.

2) In the Government Order second read above, Administrative Sanction for Land Acquisition for “Construction of ROB at Km 0/2-4 of Thirumangalam Municipality road in lieu of existing LC No. 377 at Railway km 512/400-500 in between Thirumangalam and Kallikudi Railway Stations” for Rs.17.10 Crores was accorded pending clearance of No Objection Certificate from the Commissioner, Hindu Religious and Charitable Endowments Department.

3) The Chief Engineer (H), Projects in his letter third read above has stated that “Construction of ROB at Km 0/2-4 of Thirumangalam Municipality road in lieu of existing LC No. 377 at Railway km 512/400-500 in between Thirumangalam and Kallikudi Railway Stations” was announced by the former Chief Minister under Rule 110 on the floor of Legislative Assembly on 25.09.2015 and was included under RWP scheme 2015-16.

4) The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department has further stated that the proposed ROB is located at Level Crossing No. 377 at Railway Km 512/400-500 of Thirumangalam town in between Thirumangalam and kallikudi Railway Stations and lies at Km 0/2-4 of Thirumangalam Municipality Road which leads to Madurai Airport. The Alignment for the above work was finalized and approved by the alignment committee on 19.01.2017. The field particulars for the above work was communicated to the Chief Engineer (H), Planning, Design and Investigation for the preparation of Detailed Estimate and Drawings on 18.02.2020. After resolving the issues of Railway land boundary disputes, reduction in the Railway Super Structure depth which delayed the progress of the work and further improving the geometry of curve on the Railway portion to avoid extra widening and super elevation on the Railway portion, the approved Railway GAD for the above work was received from the Railways on 15.09.2020.

5) The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department has stated that based on the approved Railway GAD and field particulars, the Chief Engineer (H), Planning, Design and Investigation has prepared and communicated the detailed quantity estimate and structural drawings for the above work.

6) The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department has stated that based on the approved drawings and Quantity Estimate, the Superintending Engineer (H), Projects, Madurai submitted the cost estimate for the above work adopting the current schedule of rates 2020-21 and the value of project, works out to Rs.35.65 Crores.

7) The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department has further stated that Thirumangalam is one of the thickly populated Municipal Town in Madurai District and is busy throughout the day and night. The Railway Level crossing No. 377 is situated at Km 0/2-4 of Thirumangalam-Municipality road. The people from Thirumangalam often cross the above level crossing for their way to Vidathakukam, Virusankulam, Alangalum and many other villages. The vehicles crossing over this LC are constantly getting hampered owing to frequent gate closures. As this is a densely populated area, the residents and students finds very difficult to reach nearby market, hospital, bus stand, temples and educational institutions. All agricultural produces from nearby villages are being carried through this level crossing to reach the marketing centres. This road also connects to the Madurai Airport. Based on above circumstances, the Construction of ROB at this Railway level crossing is very much essential to promote free flow of traffic in Thirumangalam.

8) The Chief Engineer (H), Projects has therefore requested the orders of the Government to accord Administrative Sanction for the work of "Construction of ROB at Km 0/2-4 of Thirumangalam Municipality road in lieu of existing LC No. 377 at Railway km 512/400-500 in between Thirumangalam and Kallikudi Railway Stations" for an amount of Rs.35,65,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Five Crores Sixty Five Lakhs only).

9) The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Projects), and accord Administrative Sanction for the work of "Construction of ROB at Km 0/2-4 of Thirumangalam Municipality road in lieu of existing Level Crossing No. 377 at Railway km 512/400-500 in between Thirumangalam and Kallikudi Railway Stations" at a restricted cost of Rs.30,43,82,289/- (Rupees Thirty Crore Forty Three Lakh Eighty Two Thousand and Two Hundred and Eighty Nine Only) and accord

financial sanction for a sum of Rs.20,00,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Crore Only) for the financial year 2020-2021.

10) The amount sanctioned in para 9 above shall be debited under the following head of account:-

“5054 – Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 03 – State Highways – 101 – Bridges – State’s Expenditure – JG – Construction of over and under bridges in lieu of Existing level crossings – 416 – Major Works” – 01.Major Works.

11) The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 9 above.

12) The expenditure sanctioned in Para 9 above shall constitute an item of “New Instrument of Service” and approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G-I) Department directly in Form ‘A’ appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department is also directed to send a draft explanatory notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2020-2021 to Finance (PW-I) Department without fail.

13) This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.63/DS(SA)/PW-I, dated.17.02.2021and ASL No.1792 (One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Two).
