## ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued to form a review committee with the following members and functions with effect from 01.04.2013 onwards as detailed below:-

1. Project Director, Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project-II.
2. Chief Engineer, (Construction & Maintenance), Highways Department.
3. Chief Engineer, (Planning, Design & Investigation), Highways Department.

## The functions of the Review Committee:-

- a. Review of all reports and documents placed before the Review Committee by the TNRSP -II PIU submitted by the consultants.
- b. Approval of all the reports and documents scrutinized by the TNRSP -II PIU.
- c. To give Technical sanction for all the TNRSP -II works prepared and submitted by the consultant (including PPP) and scrutinized by Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project -II(PIU)

2. In the Government Order second read above, Government accorded permission to include the Chief Engineer, Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project-II as one of the members in the Review Committee.

3. In the Government Order third read above, Government accorded sanction for the formation of Project Implementation unit and Field Implementation unit with 295 posts for Chennai Kanniyakumari Industrial Corridor Project.

4. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project-II in his letter fourth read above, has stated that Tamil Nadu State Highways is purely a Technical department with the core subject of construction and maintenance of roads and bridges. Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project - II is a wing of State Highways Department formed for the implementation of the project with loan assistance from the World Bank. The implementation of Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project - II has involved many line departments like Revenue Department, Forest Department, Finance Department, Treasuries and Account Department, Tamil Nadu Pollution control Board for the purpose of Land Acquisition, Tree plantation, mitigation of Environmental and social impact & pollution control. In order to facilitate seamless co-ordination among many line departments, interaction with the District Collectors and liaison with World Bank and Government of India officials, an I.A.S., officer has been posted as Head of Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project-II i.e Project Director wherein other wings of Highways Department are headed by technical person in the cadre Chief Engineer.

5. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project -II has also stated that the Chennai Kanniyakumari Industrial Corridor Project has been formed for the improvement of 15 road works with loan assistance from Asian Development Bank headed by Project Director in the cadre of IAS Officer. Further, at the time of formation of Review Committee, for TNRSP-II the post of Chief Engineer (H), had not been established whereas now the Government have created the post of Chief Engineer (H), Chennai Kanniyakumari Industrial Corridor Project in the Highways Department. Therefore, it is more appropriate to include the Chief Engineer (H), Chennai Kanniyakumari Industrial Corridor Project as one of the Review Committee members for the above said functions.

6. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project -II has therefore requested the Government to issue orders for reconstituting the Review Committee with the inclusion of Chief Engineer, Chennai Kanniyakumari Industrial Corridor Project as one of the members of Review Committee.

7. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of Project Director, Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project-II accord permission to reconstitute the Review Committee with the inclusion of the Chief Engineer (H), Chennai Kanniyakumari Industrial Corridor Project as one of the members of the Review Committee with the role and responsibility as detailed below:-
