ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued constituting a Committee consisting of representatives of Finance Department, Highways and Minor Ports Department, Director General and concerned Chief Engineers of Highways Department for scrutiny and Review of Revised Administrative Sanction proposals.

2) In the Government Order second read above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for Land Acquisition for the work of "Widening from Double lane to Four Lane in Km 1/6-2/2 of Coimbatore – Siruvani Road" for an amount of Rs.165.00 Lakhs.

- 3) In the Government order third read above, 1st Revised Administrative Sanction was accorded for Land Acquisition for the work of "Widening from Double lane to Four Lane in Km 1/6-2/2 of Coimbatore Siruvani Road" for an amount of Rs.245.51 Lakhs.
- 4) The committee on Revised Administrative Sanction in its meeting held on 13.12.2018 has approved the following proposal of Chief Engineer (H.) Construction and Maintenance:

- 5) The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department has therefore requested the Government to approve IInd Revised Administrative Sanction for Land Acquisition for the work of "Widening from Double lane to Four Lane in Km 1/6-2/2 of Coimbatore Siruvani Road" for an amount of Rs.433.00 Lakhs as recommended by the Revised Administrative Sanction Committee.
- 6) The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department and accord IInd Revised Administrative Sanction for Land Acquisition for the work of "Widening from Double lane to Four Lane in Km 1/6-2/2 of Coimbatore Siruvani Road" for an amount of Rs.4,33,00,000/-(Rupees Four Crore and Thirty Three Lakhs only) as recommended by the Revised Administrative Sanction Committee as against 1st Revised

Adninistrative Sanction amount of Rs.2,45,51,000/- (Rupees Two Crore Forty Five Lakh and Fifty One Thousand only).

7) The expenditure sanctioned in para-6 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"5054 - Capital outlay on Roads and Bridges - 03 - State Highways - 337 - Road Works - States Expenditure JA - Original Works" - 464 Lands-01. Lands-Voted."

- 8) The expenditure sanctioned in Para 6 above is an item of "New Instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance) Highways Department, Chennai is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G-I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. He is also directed to send a draft explanatory notes for inclusion the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates/Revised Budget Estimate 2019-20 to Finance (BG-I)/(PW-I) Department without fail.
- 9) This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.20983/PW-I/2019 dated 28.05.2019 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.334 (Three Hundred and Thirty Four).
