ORDER:

In Government Order first read above, orders were issued constituting a Committee consisting of representatives of Finance Department, Highways and Minor Ports Department, Director General and concerned Chief Engineers' of Highways Department for scrutiny and Review of the Revised Administrative Sanction proposals.

2. In the Government order second read above, administrative sanction was accorded for the work of “Construction of Bridge at Km 0/4 of Kooranur road across Malattar River” for an amount of Rs.745.00 Lakhs. Technical Sanction for Rs.815.00 Lakhs has been accorded for this work.

3. The Committee on Revised Administrative Sanction in its meeting held on 03.10.2020 has approved the following proposal of Chief Engineer (Highways) NABARD and Rural Roads:

4. The Chief Engineer (Highways) NABARD & Rural Roads has therefore requested the Government to accord Revised Administrative Sanction for the work of "Construction of Bridge at Km 0/4 of Kooranur road across Malattar River" for an amount of Rs.997.00 Lakhs based on the recommendation of the Revised Administrative Sanction Committee.

5. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Highways) NABARD and Rural Roads as recommended by Revised Administrative Sanction Committee and accord Revised Administrative Sanction for the work of "Construction of Bridge at Km 0/4 of Kooranur road across Malattar River" for an amount of Rs.997.00 Lakhs (Rupees Nine Crore and Ninety Seven Lakhs only) as against the Administrative Sanction amount of Rs.745.00 Lakh and accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.2,52,00,000/-.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para-5 above shall be debited to the following Head of account:-

"5054- Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 04- District and Other Roads- 337-Road Works-State's Expenditure –JZ – Construction / Reconstruction of Bridges with Loan Assistance from NABARD-416 - Major Works-01-Major Works".

7. The Chief Engineer (Highways) NABARD and Rural Roads is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Highways) NABARD and Rural Roads is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Highways) NABARD and Rural Roads is also directed to send a draft explanatory notes for inclusion the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2020-2021 to Finance (BG-I/PW-I) Department without fail.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.7746/PW-I/2021, Dated 19.02.2021 and Additional Sanction Ledger No. 1825 (One Thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty Five)


