



ABSTRACT

Highways Department - Trichy (Highways) Construction and Maintenance Circle and Division - "Land Acquisition for the Formation of Bypass to Mannachanallur town starting from km 2/2 of Trichy - Thuraiyur road (State Highways-62) and ends at km 4/6 of the same road" - Revised Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.21.89 Crore as Recommended by Revised Administrative Sanction Committee - Accorded - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued constituting a Committee consisting representatives of Finance Department, Highways and Minor Ports Department, Director General and concerned Chief Engineers of Highways Department for scrutiny and review of the Revised Administrative Sanction proposals.

2. In the Government order second read above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for "Land Acquisition for the Formation of Bypass to Mannachanallur town starting from km 2/2 of Trichy - Thuraiyur road (SH 62) and ends at km 4/6 of the same road" for an amount of Rs.14.40 Crore and Administrative Sanction for the work of formation of the above Bypass was accorded for an amount of Rs.26.37 Crore vide Government order third read above.

3. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance in the letter fourth read above has stated that the length of Mannachanallur Bypass is 2.620 Km and the Land Acquisition of 7.00 Hectares area of land for the above work involves three villages namely Mannachanallur, Ulunthankudi and Poonampalayam. In Mannachanallur village and Ulunthankudi village 4.71 Hectares area of land and in

Poonampalayam village 2.29 Hectares area of land are to be acquired for the formation of Mannachanallur Bypass road. The land acquisition process has been completed on 22.12.2020. The Bypass construction work has been completed on 19.01.2021 and public traffic was allowed from 13.02.2021.

4. The Committee on Revised Administrative Sanction in its meeting held on 22.09.2021, approved the following proposal of Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance:

As per the demand from the District Revenue Officer, Trichirapalli District vide letter dated 16.03.2018 and 22.12.2020 the total cost of Land Acquisition works out to Rs.21.89 Crore including Advertisement Charges and petty supervision and contingencies charges.

5. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance has therefore requested the Government to accord the Revised Administrative Sanction for the work of "Land Acquisition for the Formation of Bypass to Mannachanallur town starting from km 2/2 of Trichy-Thuraiyur road (SH 62) and ends at km 4/6 of the same road" for an amount of Rs.21,89,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Crore and Eighty Nine Lakh only) based on the recommendation of the Revised Administrative Sanction Committee.

6. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance as recommended by Revised Administrative Sanction Committee accord Revised Administrative Sanction for a sum of Rs.21,89,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Crore and Eighty Nine Lakh only) for the work of "Land Acquisition for the Formation of Bypass to Mannachanallur town starting from km 2/2 of Trichy-Thuraiyur road (SH 62) and ends at km 4/6 of the same road" as against the Administrative Sanction amount of Rs.14.40 Crore and accord Financial sanction for a sum of Rs.7,49,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Crore and Forty Nine Lakh only)

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para-6 above shall be debited to the following Head of account:

"5054-Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges - 04 - District and Other Roads - 800 - Other Expenditure - State Expenditure -JK - Acquisition of lands for Bypass - 464 -Lands-01. Lands."

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para-6 above is an item of "New Instrument of Service" and approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance, is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Highways) Construction and Maintenance is also directed to send a draft explanatory notes for inclusion the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023 to Finance (BG-I)/(PW-I) Department without fail.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.17274/PW.I/2022, dated 23.04.2022 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.0071 (Seventy One)
