



## ABSTRACT

Announcement – Announcements made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister during the Collector's Conference held on 11-13<sup>th</sup> December 2013 – Acquisition of land for the "Widening and Ground Level improvement of Dindigul Bangalore Road (NH 209), Pollachi Palaghat Road (SH 78A), Municipal Bus Route Road (ODR) and New Scheme Road (Pollachi Municipal Road) in Pollachi Town" – Administrative Sanction – Accorded – Orders - Issued.

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### **ORDER:**

During the Collectors' Conference held on 11-13<sup>th</sup> of December 2013, the Hon'ble Chief Minister has made an announcement that "**Construction of Flyover in Pollachi Municipality to facilitate hassle free traffic**".

2. In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued sanctioning a sum of Rs.20.00 lakhs for the preparation of "Detailed Project Report for the construction of Flyover in Pollachi Municipality".

3. Based on the above announcement, the Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department in his letter second read above has stated that, for continuation of flyover in Pollachi Municipality Town as per the approved alignment the Land acquisition is involved to an extent of 9602.71 Sqm. Out of this 3665.96 Sqm belongs to Government land and the remaining extent of 5936.75 Sqm lies in Private land. The land value proposal is prepared based on the guide line value furnished by Registration Department and as per guidelines given in the First Schedule of the New Land Acquisition act (RFCTLARR 2013). The total cost of land acquisition for the "Construction of Flyover along Dindigul Bangalore Road (NH 209), Pollachi Palaghat

Road (SH 78A), Municipal Bus Route Road (ODR) and New Scheme Road (Pollachi Municipal Road) in Pollachi Town” is finalized for Rs.33.57 Crores after including Solatium of 100%, 12% for market value, 30% for Rehabilitation and Resettlement, 1% for advertisement charges and 2.5% for contingencies.

4. The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department has therefore requested the Government, to accord Administration Sanction for a sum of Rs.33.57 Crores for acquisition of land for the “Construction of Flyover along Dindigul Bangalore Road (NH 209), Pollachi Palaghat Road (SH 78A), Municipal Bus Route Road (ODR) and New Scheme Road (Pollachi Municipal Road) in Pollachi Town”.

5. The Government after careful examination, accord administrative sanction for a sum of **Rs.33.57 Crores (Rupees Thirty Three Crores and Fifty Seven Lakhs Only) for acquisition of land for the “Widening and Ground Level improvement of Dindigul Bangalore Road (NH 209), Pollachi Palaghat Road (SH 78A), Municipal Bus Route Road (ODR) and New Scheme Road (Pollachi Municipal Road) in Pollachi Town”** instead of construction of flyover in Pollachi Municipality.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para-5 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

“5054 – Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 04 – District and Other Roads – 337 – Road Works – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan– II–State Plan – KC – Acquisition of Lands for bye passes” – 64 – Lands.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above is an item of “New Service”. The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department, Chennai is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G.I) Department directly in Form ‘A’ appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G.I) Department. He is also requested to send a draft explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Revised Budget Estimate 2016-2017/Supplementary Estimate 2016-2017 to Finance (BG-I) Department without fail.

8. This Order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department Vide its U.O. No.16010/PW–I/2016, dated 04-03-2016 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.2569 (Two Thousand Five Hundred and Sixty Nine).
