Highways Department – Tamil Nadu Road Infrastructure Development Corporation – Land Acquisition – Madurai Ring Road Project – Additional toll lanes at the toll plaza locations of Vandiyur-1 Bit Chinthamani and Valayankulam Villages – Revised Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.3,32,70,794/- - Accorded Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, orders have been issued according Administrative Sanction of Rs.200.00 crore for the work of "Widening the Madurai Ring Road from double lane to four lane from km.0/0-27/2". In the Government order second read above, the Government had ordered to take up the above project through Tamil Nadu Road Infrastructure Development Corporation (TNRIDC) under Build Operate Transfer (BOT) using suitable Viability Gap Funding.

2. In the Government order third read above, orders have been issued according Administrative Sanction for an amount of Rs.67,13,667/- to acquire land to a total extent of 16,758 Sq.mts. Further, it was informed in the Government Order that necessary financial sanction will be provided in the financial year 2019-2020. Necessary financial

sanction for an amount of Rs.67,13,667/- has been accorded in Government order fifth read above, this amount has been deposited in the head of account of the Revenue Divisional Officer, Madurai through the Divisional Engineer, Highways, Construction and Maintenance, Madurai on 14.08.2020, for making payment of compensation.

3. Meanwhile, for this land acquisition, 15(1) notification under Tamil Nadu Highways Act 2001 (Tamil Nadu Act 34 of 2002) was issued in Government order fourth read above and notified in Tamil Nadu Government Gazette Extraordinary No.108, dated 07.03.2019 respectively. The District Collector, Madurai has arrived the compensation amount as Rs.4,12,82,680/- for making compensation to the land owners, in respect of Valayankulam Village (6426 Sqmt), Chinthamani Village (5094 Sqmt) and for the Vandiyur Bit-I Village (5783 Sqmt), with tentative value of compensation of Rs.1,21,35,745/-, Rs.1,03,92,805/- & Rs.1,87,54,130/- respectively (Total cost Rs.4,12,82,680/-). The above amount of Rs.4,12,82,680/- earmarked by the District Collector, Madurai is inclusive of the compensation amount for the well in S.No.8/2B of Valayankulam Village. Regarding this well, the Government have approved the withdrawal proposal of the District Collector, Madurai in vide Government order sixth read above and the same has been notified in Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, Extraordinary No.388, dated 22.09.2020. Under the above circumstances, the Revised Administrative Sanction proposal for Rs.3,32,70,794/- (Rs.4,12,82,680 - Rs.80,11,886) as against Administrative Sanction of Rs.67,13,667/- was placed before the Tamil Nadu Road Infrastructure Development Corporation Board in its meeting held 18.11.2020, for its consideration. The Board discussed and deliberated the above subject and indicated that the Revised Administrative Sanction proposal, for Land Acquisition does not have any design aspects and hence this proposal need not to be placed before committee for Revised Administrative Sanction, since the other member of the committee except Chief Engineer, Design are the Board of Director and representative of Chairman and Managing Director and hence resolved to authorize the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Road Infrastructure Development Corporation to send necessary Revised Administrative Sanction proposal for Rs.3,32,70,794/- to the Government directly.

4. The Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Road Infrastructure Development Corporation has therefore furnished the proposal and requested the Government to accord Revised Administrative Sanction for Rs.3,32,70,794/- as against the Administrative Sanction of Rs.67,13,667/- towards the cost of land acquisition, to provide additional toll lanes at three toll plaza locations for the work of "Widening the Madurai Ring Road from double lane to four lane from km 0/0 – 27/2".

5. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Road Infrastructure Development Corporation and accord Revised Administrative Sanction for Rs.3,32,70,794/- (Rupees Three Crore Thirty Two Lakhs Seventy Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Four Only) as against the Administrative Sanctioned Amount of Rs.67,13,667/- towards the cost of land acquisition, to provide additional toll lanes at three toll plaza locations for the work of "Widening the Madurai Ring Road from double lane to four lane from km 0/0 – 27/2".

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of Account:

“5054 – Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 03. State Highways – 337. Road works – State's expenditure – JM – widening to four lane of Madurai Ring Road through Tamil Nadu Road Infrastructure Development Corporation – 464. Lands – 01. Lands.”

7. The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in Para 5 above shall constitute an item of “New Instrument of Service” and approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form ‘A’ appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Construction and Maintenance), Highways Department is also directed to send a draft explanatory notes for inclusion the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2021–2022 to Finance (BG-I) Department without fail.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.25722/PW-I/2021, dated:05.08.2021 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.287 (Two Hundred and Eighty Seven).


