

ABSTRACT

National Highways – Centrally Sponsored Scheme – Revamped Central Road Fund Scheme 2017-18 – Administrative sanction accorded by the Government of India, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways for 50 works – Financial sanction of the State Government – Accord – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:-

In the letters first read above, the Chief Engineer(National Highways), Highways Department has sent the additional proposals for obtaining administrative approval of the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways under Revamped Central Road Fund Scheme 2016-2017.

2. In the Government letter second read above, necessary proposals have been forwarded to Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India, New Delhi for obtaining approval of the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways.

- 3. Accordingly, in their letter third read above, the Government of India, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has accorded administrative approval for 50 works amounting to Rs.35591.90 lakhs under the Revamped Central Road Fund Scheme 2017-18 and requested the State Government to accord financial and technical sanction for the individual projects within a period of 4 months from the date of administrative approval, failing which the works shall deemed to have been de-sanctioned as per Central Road Fund Rules, 2007.
- 4. The Government of India have also imposed the following conditions and following of e-procurement:
 - i) Accord technical and financial sanction to the individual projects within a period of four months from the date of administration approval of the works failing which the works will be deemed to have been deleted from the programme.
 - ii) In any case, the period of completion of project should not exceed 24 months including the period for tendering.
 - iii) Any excess cost beyond 10% will have to be arranged by Government of Tamil Nadu from their own resources.
 - iv) No revised estimate will be considered in this scheme.
 - v) Audit shall admit expenditure on the basis of technically approved and financially sanctioned estimate by the Competent State / UT authority.
 - vi) No additional fund in excess of the possible allocation of fund as per Central Road Fund Act, 2000 would be allocated to the States / UT.
 - vii) The Government of Tamil Nadu shall ensure that progress of works would not suffer due to delay in payments for want of additional funds under Central Road Fund.
 - viii) Payment of Bills in excess of possible allocation of funds, as per Central Road Fund Act, 2000. If needed, is to be temporarily arranged by the State Government.
 - The stipulation made in Ministry's circular letter No.NH-11011/2/2000-P&M(Pt), dated 08.08.2007 (Notification No. GSR 475-E, dated 10.07.2007) shall be strictly followed.
 - x) If the approved road merges with any National Highways, the detail of such junction / location shall be got approved from this Ministry / National Highways Authority of India before entrusting the work.
 - xi) The funds used for the project approved as per guidelines circulated to various State Government / UTs as per this Ministry's letter No.RW/NH-11011/2/ 2000-P&M (pt), dated 08.08.2007 (Notification No.GSR 475-E, dated 10.07.2007).
 - xii) Display boards should be erected on the sanctioned works.

- xiii) The State / UT has to submit quarterly progress report of all works sanctioned from the Central Road Fund for the quarter ending June, September, December and March each year in the prescribed proforma as circulated vide Ministry letter No.RW/NH-11011/2/ 2000-P&M (Pt), dated 08.08.2007 (GSR No.475 (E) dated 10.07.2007). The progress report should reach the Ministry not later than one month from the date ending for each quarter.
- The Government of Tamil Nadu will be required to furnish work wise utilization certificate as per Ministry circular No.RW/NH-11011/2/2000-P&M (Pt), dated 08.08.2007 (Notification No. GSR 475-E, dated 10.07.2007) along with quarterly progress report. Further installment of funds will be released to the extent of expenditure incurred as per utilization certificate by 30th April each year.
- xv) The Government of Tamil Nadu should furnish completion certificate duly vetted by Audit after completion of works as stipulated in the sanction in para-4 (xiv) above.
- xvi) While according technical and financial sanction, it may be ensured that the contingencies, works charged establishment and quality control charges are as per Ministry's guidelines.
- xvii) The approval is subject to the condition that Government of Tamil Nadu shall furnish all the relevant details of the roads considered as per Central Road Fund Rules viz. index map showing the area and the proposal, scope / specification of the work in brief, estimated cost of the project based on the actual requirement and proposed starting / completion dated etc., and upgradation of category of roads as per Central Road Fund rules prior to taking up the work.
- xviii) The expenditure is debitable under Major Head-3601 (Plan) Grants-in-Aid to State Government; 02-Grants for State Plan Schemes (Sub-Major Head); 02.105-Grants from Central Road Fund (Minor-Head); 01-Grants for State Road; 01.00.35 Grants for Creation of Capital assets corresponding the Demand No.81 of the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways for the Financial year 2017-18.
- xix) The sanction is subject to obtaining the necessary approval, if needed for carrying out the work from other Department like Railways, Forest etc.,
- 5. The Chief Engineer (National Highways), Highways Department has therefore requested the Government to accord financial sanction for 50 works amounting to Rs.35591.90 lakhs before the prescribed time limit (4 months) as per Central Road Fund Rules, 2007 to avoid de-sanction of the works approved by the Government of India under Revamped Central Road Fund Scheme 2017-18.
- 6. The Government, after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (National Highways), Highways Department and accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.35591.90 lakhs (Rupees Three hundred fifty five crore ninety

one lakh and ninety thousand only) for 50 works (annexed to this order) under Revamped Central Road Fund Scheme for the year 2017-18 and the Government now accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.10000.00 lakh (Rupees one hundred crore only) for the year 2017-18 and the balance will be released based on the needs.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in Para-6 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

"5054 – Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 05 Roads – 800 – Other Expenditure – Central Sector Schemes – SA – Revamped Central Road Fund – 16 Major works.

- 8. Necessary additional funds of Rs.100.00 crore will be provided in RE/FMA 2017-18. Pending provision of funds, the Chief Engineer (National Highways) is authorized to incur the expenditure. The expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislative Assembly by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2017-2018. The Chief Engineer (National Highways) is directed to include this item of expenditure while sending the budget proposal for RE/FMA 2017-18 and also send draft explanatory note for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2017-18 to Government in Finance (BG-1/PW-1) Department without fail.
- 9. The Chief Engineer (National Highways), Highways Department is directed to accord technical sanction for the works (annexed to this order) within a period of 4 months from the date of administrative approval of the works, failing which the works will be deemed to be deleted from the programme. In any case, the period of completion of the project should not exceed 24 months including periods for tendering. No revised estimates will be considered in this scheme at any cost.
- 10. The Chief Engineer (National Highways), Highways Department is directed to comply with the following conditions:
 - i) Furnish necessary particulars to Government of India in the prescribed format upon the technical sanction of estimates for all the works sanctioned from Central Road Fund under intimation to the State Government.
 - ii) Ensure that the conditions laid down by Government of India, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways as stated at Para-4 above are complied with while implementing the works.
 - iii) Ensure that the amount provided for Central Road Fund works are restricted only to the schemes identified and approved by Government of India.

- 11. The Chief Engineer (National Highways), Highways Department is also directed to ensure that the sanctioned works are not included in any other scheme such as Tamil Nadu Road Sector Project, General Maintenance Works, Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme, Panchayat Union Schemes etc.
- 12. The Chief Engineer (National Highways), Highways Department is also directed to furnish the Utilization Certificate along with quarterly progress report from the date of ending of each quarter and get the expenditure reimbursed from Government of India.
- 13. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.50220/PW-1/2017, dated 09-10-2017 and A.S.L.No.1561 (one thousand five hundred and sixty one)
