1. G.O.(Ms).No.127, Highways and Minor Ports (HP2) Department dated 10.12.2021.
2. From the Chief Engineer (H) Construction and Maintenance Letter No.14616/LA/2022 Dated 01.12.2022, 28.08.2023, 03.02.2024 and 18.03.2024.

ORDER:

During the Budget Session 2021-2022, it was announced that to reduce the traffic congestion and increase Road Safety, Detailed Project Reports shall be prepared at a cost of Rs.9.83 Crore for 15 Bypasses. Sendurai Bypass is one among the 15 bypasses.

2. In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued according Administrative Sanction for Preparation of Detailed Project Report for “Formation of Bypass to Sendurai Town” for an amount of Rs.21.00 Lakh.

3. In this regard, the Chief Engineer (H) Construction and Maintenance in his letter second read above has stated that, Ariyalur is a town and headquarters of Ariyalur district in Tamil Nadu. It is rich in limestone surrounded with seven cement factories and two sugar factories. Sendurai is located 20 Km from Ariyalur and a Taluk headquarters. The following roads pass through Sendurai Town (i)Ariyalur–Jeyankondam Road (via) Sendurai (SH-217) (ii) Sendurai – Udayarpalayam - Annaikarai Road (MDR - 684).

4. The Chief Engineer (H) Construction and Maintenance has stated that, due to the movement of Trucks, Lorries and other commercial

vehicles from Ariyalur, the town area of Sendurai faces frequent traffic congestion. The road stretch also runs in the thickly populated residential and commercial establishment area. The carriageway of Ariyalur – Jeyamkondan Road (SH-217) in Sendurai Town is 7.00m wide only and it cannot be widened further as it is a built-up area. Hence, Bypass road for Sendurai Town is very much necessary.

5. The Chief Engineer (H) Construction and Maintenance has also stated that, the Alignment proposal for the above work has been scrutinized by the Alignment Committee. On exploring the three alignment options, the committee has approved the alignment that starts at Km 18/830 of Ariyalur – Jeyankondam Road (via) Sendurai (SH - 217) and ends at Km 23/875 of the same road. The total length of the formation of the road is 4697.00m (4.697 Km). This alignment runs through dry and agricultural lands, intersects Elangaichery road (Panchayat Road) at Km 0/667, intersects Sendurai – Udaiyarpalayam – Annaikarai (MDR - 684). This bypass road is to be formed for a minimum width of 30.00m. As per the above standard, the land to be acquired is approximately 16.91 hectares (or) 41.79 acres including Private and Government lands.

6. The Chief Engineer (H) Construction and Maintenance has therefore requested orders of the Government to accord Administrative Sanction for "Land Acquisition for the Formation of Bypass at Sendurai Town" at a cost of Rs.4,90,00,000/-.

7. The Government after careful examination, decided to accept the proposal of Chief Engineer (H) Construction and Maintenance and hereby accord Administrative Sanction for the work of "Land Acquisition for the Formation of Bypass at Sendurai Town" at a cost of Rs.4,90,00,000/- (Rupees Four Crore and Ninety Lakh only). The project construction cost should met out from Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme (CRIDP) for the year 2024-2025.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 7 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

5054 - Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges - 04 District
and Other Roads-337 Road works State's Expenditure -KC
- Acquisition of Lands for bypasses - 464 - Lands-01.

9. The Chief Engineer (H) Construction and Maintenance is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para-7 above.
