

ABSTRACT

Highways Department – Projects Wing – Coimbatore (H) Circle – Coimbatore (H) Division - Railway Works Programme 2015-16 – Construction of Road Over Bridge at railway Km 26/500-600 in lieu of existing LC.No.11 and Construction of Limited Use Subway at Railway Km 26/100-200 in between Karamadai and Mettupalayam Railway Stations - Administrative Sanction - Accorded - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above, among others, Administrative Sanction was accorded for a sum of Rs.19.93 lakhs for the preparation of Detailed Project Report for the work of "Construction of Road Over Bridge at Km 0/4 of Karamadai—Tholampalayam road in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.11 at Railway Km.26/1-2 in between Karamadai and Mettupalayam Railways Stations" under Railway Works Programme 2015-16 on cost sharing basis with Southern Railways.

- 2. In the Government order second read above, orders were issued for changing the nomenclature of the work of "Construction of Road Over Bridge at Km 0/4 of Karamadai Tholampalayam road in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.11 at Railway Km.26/100-200 in between Karamadai and Mettupalayam Railway Stations" as "Construction of Road Over Bridge at Railway Km 26/500-600 in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.11 and Construction of Limited Use Subway at Railway Km 26/100-200 between Karamadai and Mettupalayam Stations" and Administrative Sanction was accorded to a tune of Rs.16,58,82,866/- for acquisition of 22095 square meters of lands.
- 3. In the letters third read above, the Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department has stated that, for the construction of above said Road Over Bridge, out of

22,095 Sqm area, individuals gave consent to acquire 5,980.04 Sqm area to the District Revenue Officer, Coimbatore and the proposal was also approved by the Commissioner of Land Administration, Chennai. The remaining 16,204.94 Sqm area of land has to be acquired under Highways Act, was held up due to the Court Case filed in the Supreme Court of India. The exact value of Land Acquisition can be ascertained only after pronouncement of final award by the District Revenue Officer, Coimbatore based on the Judgement of the Supreme Court of India in the above case.

- 4. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department, has sent a proposal, by adopting the Schedule of rates for the year 2018-19 to a tune of Rs.36.85 Crores. (which will be revised as per current schedule of rates to accord Technical sanction as per Chapter IV, Clause 13.2.C of Tender Transparency Act, 2000) and requested the Government to accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.36.85 Crores for the work of "Construction of Road Over Bridge at Km 26/500-600 in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.11 and Construction of Limited Use Subway at Railway Km.26/100-200 in between Karamadai and Mettupalayam Railway Stations".
- 5. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department and accord administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.34,23,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Four Crore and Twenty Three Lakh only) for the work of "Construction of Road Over Bridge at Km 26/500-600 in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.11 and Construction of Limited Use Subway at Railway Km 26/100-200 in between Karamadai and Mettupalayam Railway Stations" and also accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.1,00,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore only) for the year 2020-2021. The balance amount will be provided in subsequent financial year based on needs.
- 6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

"5054 – Capital Outlay on Roads and Bridges – 03. State Highways – 101. Bridges – State's Expenditure – JG – Construction of over and under bridges in lieu of Existing Level Crossings – 416 Major works – 01 Major works"

- 7. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above.
- 8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next supplementary

estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department is also directed to send a draft explanatory notes for inclusion the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2020-2021 to Finance (B.G-I / PW-I) Department without fail.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.18095/PW-I/2020, dated 20.07.2020 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.229 (Two hundred and twenty nine)
