### **ORDER:**

During the budget session of the Legislative Assembly for the year 2017-2018, the Hon'ble Minister for Industries has made the following announcement:-

2) In the G.O. 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, Administrative sanction was accorded for the formation of District Offices of the Geology and Mining Department at Chennai, Perambalur and Thiruvarur with the following Staff Pattern:-

The Director of Geology and Mining shall also be advised to send necessary draft explanatory notes to Finance (Industries) Department for inclusion of this expenditure in the Final Supplementary Estimates for the year 2019-2020 without fail.
