## **ORDER:**

During the budget session of 2018-2019, the Hon'ble Minister (Law, Courts and Prisons), while moving the demand for Industries on the floor of the Assembly has made the following announcement:-

''புவியியல் மற்றும் சுரங்கத்துறையில் தற்போது உள்ள ஈப்பு வாகனங்கள் மிகவும் பழுதடைந்த நிலையில் உள்ளதால், மாவட்ட அளவில் களப்பணி ஆய்வு மற்றும் கனிம நிர்வாகத்தினை திறன்பட செயல்படுத்த, தலைமையகத்திற்கு 5 புதிய ஈப்பு வாகனங்களும், மண்டல அலுவலகம், பறக்கும்படை மற்றும் மாவட்ட அலுவலகங்களுக்கு 20 புதிய ஈப்பு வாகனங்களும் என மொத்தம் 25 புதிய ஈப்பு வாகனங்கள் ரூபாய் 2 கோடி செலவில் வாங்கப்படும்."

2) In order to implement the announcement, the Director of Geology and Mining has requested the Government to sanction Rs.2 crore towards the purchase of 25 vehicles (Rs.8.00 lakh  $\times$  25) and also requested to sanction 12 new driver posts, along with the cost as salary of driver and fuel to the tune of Rs.46,78,000/-as follows:-

<sup>3)</sup> Earlier in the G.O. second read above, sanction was accorded for the creation of Regional Flying Squads in Madurai, Salem and Villupuram in the Department of Geology and Mining with 3 Assistant Directors, 3 Assistant Geologists, 3 Special Revenue Inspectors (Mines) totaling 9 posts and 3 vehicles and 3 drivers have been ordered to be utilized from the sanction already accorded in the G.O.  $1^{\rm st}$  read above.

- 4) In the G.O. 5<sup>th</sup> read above, Administrative Sanction was accorded for the formation of Geology and Mining Office at Chennai, Perambalur and Thiruvarur wherein, among others, the Government have sanctioned 3 driver posts (consolidated) and also permitted for purchase of 3 Mahindra Bolero vehicles, one for each district by following due procedure.
- 5) Further, a proposal for the formation of Regional Flying Squad at Tiruchirappalli District, is under consideration of Government separately. The said proposal includes purchase of one vehicle and sanction of a driver post.
- 6) Taking into consideration of the above said position, this Department has decided to sanction 18 vehicles and 5 drivers (consolidated pay) as follows:

7) The Government, after careful consideration, hereby permit the Director of Geology and Mining to purchase 18 vehicles (Bolero Jeeps) by following due procedure and sanction of 5 drivers posts on consolidated pay of Rs.12,000/per month. Accordingly, the Government hereby sanction a total sum of Rs.1,45,02,780/- (Rupees one crore, forty five lakh, two thousand seven hundred and eighty only) to strengthen the Office of the Headquarters of the Department of Geology and Mining, Regional Offices, Flying squads and District Offices and for the effective mineral administration as follows:-

9) The expenditure sanctioned Rs.1,45,02,780/- (Rupees One Crore Forty Five Lakh Two Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty only) in para 7 above constitute an item of "New Instrument of Service" and the approval of the Legislature shall be obtained in due course of time by an inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2019-2020. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawl of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Director of Geology and Mining is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG.I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG.I) Department. The Director of

Geology and Mining shall also send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2019-2020 at appropriate time without fail.
