ORDER:

During the Budget Session 2014-2015, the Hon'ble Chief Minister has inter-alia made the following announcement on 24.7.2014 under Rule 110 of Tamil Nadu Assembly Rules, pertaining to State Industries Promotion Corporation of Tamil Nadu Limited (SIPCOT).

Considering the importance of protecting the Environment and revival of the decaying Forests, SIPCOT will take steps to plant and maintain the trees on both the sides of the roads at an interval of 10 meters in 20 SIPCOT Industrial Parks in 12 districts of Tamil Nadu at a cost of Rs.5 Crores (Rupees Five Crores only). SIPCOT will also enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Forest Department for planting and maintaining these trees.

2. In view of the importance to implement the above scheme announced by the Hon'ble Chief Minister in time, the Government after careful consideration accord in-principle approval to the Managing Director, SIPCOT to implement the above announcement expeditiously.
