ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, the Government has accorded administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.29,97,79,442/- (Rupees Twenty Nine Crore Ninety Seven Lakh Seventy Nine Thousand Four Hundred and Forty Two only) to Guidance for Development of a comprehensive Single Window Portal, IT system Development and maintenance for improving Operation and Maintenance of IT systems relating to Ease of Doing Business at Guidance and also sanctioned a sum of Rs.9,88,74,505/- (Rupees Nine Crore Eighty Eight Lakh Seventy Four Thousand Five Hundred and Five only) for the year 2020–2021.

- 2. In the letter second read above, the Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer, Guidance has stated as follows:
 - i. As per the Administrative sanction issued in the G.O. first cited, a sum of Rs.5,11,46,573/- (Rupees Five Crore Eleven Lakh forty Six Thousand Five Hundred and Seventy Three only) has been allocated to Guidance for the year 2021-2022. This amount has also been included in BE 2021-2022 under

the head of account: "2852-80-800-JX Implementation and maintenance of online systems for improving the Ease of Doing Business in Tamil Nadu (DP: 2852 80 800 JX 30903)". But due to the Covid 19 pandemic situation, the System Integrator/ Vendor has not achieved the milestone of the works assigned to them during the financial year 2021 - 2022. Hence, the amount has not been drawn and paid to them during the year 2021-2022 and the same was surrendered to the Government in the FMA – I for the year 2021-2022.

- ii. Now, the system Integrator/Vendor has completed the milestone of the works assigned to them. Hence, the pending amount of Rs.5,11,46,573/- for the year 2021-2022 has to be paid to TCS during this year.
- 3. Therefore, the Managing Director and Chief Executive Officer, Guidance has requested the Government to sanction and release the amount of Rs.5,11,46,573/- (Rupees Five Crore Eleven Lakh Forty Six Thousand Five Hundred and Seventy Three only) allocated to Guidance during the last financial year 2021–2022 under the head of account: "2852-80-800-JX implementation and maintenance of online systems for improving the Ease of Doing Business in Tamil Nadu (DPC:2852 80 800 JX 30903)" which has been surrendered to the Government in FMA I 2021–2022. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce may also be authorized to draw and disburse the amount to Guidance Tamil Nadu at the earliest.
- 4. The Government, after careful examination, sanction a sum of Rs.5,11,46,573/- (Rupees Five Crore Eleven Lakh Forty Six Thousand Five Hundred and Seventy Three only) to Guidance for Development of a comprehensive Single Window Portal, IT system Development and maintenance for improving operation and maintenance of IT systems relating to Ease of Doing Business.
- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 4 above, shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2852 – Industries – 80 – General – 800 – Other Expenditure – State's Expenditure JX Implementation and maintenance of online systems for improving the "Ease of Doing Business" in Tamil Nadu – 309 – Grants – in – Aid – 03 – Grants for specific Schemes.

IFHRMS DPC - 2852 - 80 - 800 - JX309 - 03".

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.5,11,46,573/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2022-2023 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2022-2023. Pending provision of such funds, the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is authorized to draw and disburse the amount

sanctioned in para 4 above. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is also directed to include this item of expenditure while sending the budget proposal for RE/FMA 2022-2023 and also send necessary draft explanatory note for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2022-2023 to Government in Finance (Ind/BG.1) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

- 7. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 4 above to Guidance.
- 8. This order is issued with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.36785/Fin (Ind)/2022, dated 29.07.2022 and ASL.No.0824 (Eight Hundred and Twenty Four) (IFHRMS ASL No.2022070824).
