In the Government Order first read above, the minimum rates of wages for the employment in Carpentry and Blacksmithy were revised under the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948).

2. In the Government Order second read above, a Preliminary Notification was issued in order to revise further the minimum rates of wages for the above employment.

3. In the letter 3rd read above, the Commissioner of Labour, has requested the Government to confirm the Preliminary Notification with certain modifications.

4. The Government have now decided to confirm the orders issued in the Preliminary Notification, with certain modifications.

5. The appended Notification will, accordingly, be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette both in English and Tamil. The Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-600 001 is requested to publish the Notification and send each five copies of the Gazette to the Government and the Commissioner of Labour, Chennai-600 006 for reference and record. APPENDIX.
NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 3 and sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948) and in supersession of the Labour and Employment Department Notification No. II(2)/LE/710/2014, published at pages 758 to 760 of Part II - Section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, dated the 26th November 2014, the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after consultation with the Advisory Board, hereby revises the minimum rates of wages payable to the classes of work / employees in the employment in Carpentry and Blacksmithy in the State of Tamil Nadu, specified in column (2) of the Schedule below, as specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof. the draft of the same having been previously published as required by clause (b) of sub section (1) of section 5 of the said Act.

2. This Notification shall come into force with effect on and from the date of its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

Explanations.- (1) Classification of Zones.- Zones A, B and C shall comprise of the following areas:-

- Zone A : All Corporations.
- Zone B : All Municipalities.
- Zone C : Other areas.

(2) Dearness Allowance.- In addition to the minimum rates of basic wages fixed above, the employees shall be paid dearness allowance as indicated below:-


- (i) The dearness allowance is linked to the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the year 2010, that is 161 points (with base 2001=100) and

for every raise of one point over and above 161 points, an increase of Rs.58.65 (Rupees fifty eight and paise sixty five only) per month shall be paid as dearness allowance.

- (ii) The dearness allowance shall be calculated every year on the first April on the basis of the average of the indices for the preceding twelve months that is from January to December.
 - (iii) The first calculation shall be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette based on the average Chennai City Consumer Price Index Number for the previous year.
- (3) Where the nature of work is the same, no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made in the case of male and female employees.
 - (4) To arrive at the daily rates of wages, the monthly wages shall be divided by 26.
 - (5) To arrive at the monthly rates of wages, the daily rates of wages shall be multiplied by 30.
 - (6) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the existing wages shall be continued to be paid.
