#### ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the minimum rates of wages for the employment in Food processing Industry were revised under the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948).

- 2. In the Government Order second read above, a Preliminary Notification was issued in order to revise further the minimum rates of wages for the above said employment.
- 3. The Commissioner of Labour in his letter third read above, has stated that objections and suggestions were received from the persons likely to be affected by such revision were placed in the Minimum Wages (State) Advisory Board and was decided to confirm the said Preliminary Notification without any modification. Hence the Commissioner of Labour has requested the Government to confirm the above said preliminary Notification.
- 4. The Government have now decided to confirm the orders issued in the said Preliminary Notification.
- 5. The appended Notification will, accordingly, be published in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u> both in English and Tamil. The Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-600 079 is requested to publish the Notification and send each five copies of the Gazette to the Government and the Commissioner of Labour, Chennai-600 006 for reference and record. The Director, Tamil Development and Information (Translation) Department Secretariat, Chennai-600 009 is requested to

send the Tamil Translation of the Notification direct to the Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-600 079.

# APPENDIX. NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 3 and sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948) and in supersession of the Labour and Employment Department Notification No. II(2)/LE/478/2014, published at pages 534 to 537 of Part II - Section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, dated the 13th August 2014, the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after consultation with the Advisory Board, hereby revises the minimum rates of wages payable to the classes of employees in the employment in Food Processing industry in the State of Tamil Nadu, as specified in column (2) of the Schedule below, as specified in the corresponding entries in columns (3) and (4) thereof, the draft of the same having been previously published as required by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 5 of the said Act.

2. This Notification shall come into force with effect on and from the date of its publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette

<u>Explanations</u>.- (1)<u>Classification of Zones</u>.- Zones A and B shall comprise of the following areas:-

, (1) Zone A: All Municipal Corporations.

(2) Zone B: All areas other than the areas of Municipal Corporations.

- (2) Dearness Allowance.- In addition to the minimum rates of basic wages fixed above, the employees shall be paid dearness allowance as indicated below:-
  - (i) The dearness allowance is linked to the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index for the year 2010, that is 161 points (with base 2001=100) and for every raise of one point over and above 161 points, an increase of Rs.36.00 (Rupees thirty six only) per month shall be paid as dearness allowance.

- (ii) The dearness allowance shall be calculated on the first April of every year on the basis of the average of the indices for the preceeding twelve months, that is from January to December.
- (iii) The first calculation shall be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u> based on the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index Number for the previous year.
- (3) (i) To arrive at the daily rate of wages, the monthly rate of wages shall be divided by 26.
  - (ii)To arrive at the monthly rate of wages, the daily rate of wages shall be multiplied by 30.
- (4) Where the nature of work is the same, no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made in the case of male and female employees.
- (5) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the existing wages shall be continued to be paid.
