ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the minimum rates of wages for the employment in loading and unloading operation in markets, shandies (fairs and market places) and other like places were revised under the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948).

- 2) In the Government Order second read above, a Preliminary Notification was issued in order to revise further the minimum rates of wages for the above said employment.
- 3) In the Government Order third read above, a fresh Preliminary Notification was issued for revising the minimum rates of wages for the above said employment by superceding the Preliminary Notification issued with the Government order second read above and published as Labour and Employment Notification No.II(2)/LE/156/2013 at

pages 114 and 115 of Part II – Section 2, of the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u>, dated the 6th February 2013.

- 4. In the Government order fourth read above, again a fresh Preliminary Notification was issued for revising the minimum rates of wages for the above said employment by superceding the Preliminary Notification issued with the Government order third read above and published as Labour and Employment Notification No.II(2)/LE/535/2015 at pages 631 and 632 of Part II Section 2, of the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u>, dated the 16th September 2015.
- 5. The Commissioner of Labour, in his letter fifth read above, has stated that objection and suggestion received from the persons, likely to be affected by such revision were placed before the Minimum Wages (State) Advisory Board and was decided to confirm the said Preliminary Notification without any modification. Hence, he has requested the Government to confirm the above said Preliminary Notification.
- 6. The Government have now decided to confirm the orders issued in the Government order fourth read above.
- 7. The appended Notification will, accordingly, be published in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u> both in English and Tamil. The Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-600 079 is requested to publish the Notification and send each five copies of the Gazette to the Government and the Commissioner of Labour for reference and record. The Director, Tamil Development and Information (Translation) Department, Secretariat, Chennai-600 009 is requested to send the Tamil Translation of the Notification to the Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-600 079.

APPENDIX. NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 3 and sub-section (2) of section 5 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948) and in supersession of the Labour and Employment Department Notification No. II(2)/LE/391/2009 published at pages 259 to 260 of Part II-Section 2 of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, dated the 5th August 2009, the Governor of Tamil Nadu, after consultation with the Advisory Board hereby revises the minimum rates of wages payable to the classes of work in the employment in loading and unloading operations in markets, shandies, (Fairs and market places) and other like places in the State of Tamil Nadu specified in column (2) of the Schedule below, as specified in the corresponding entries in column (3) thereof, the draft of the same having been previously published as required by clause (b) of sub-section (1) of section 5 of the said Act.

2. This Notification shall come into force with effect on and from the date of its Publication in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

Explanations:

(1) Classification of Zones .-

Zone – A: Corporations and Special Grade Municipalities.

Zone – B: Other Municipalities.

Zone – C: Other places (not covered under Zones 'A' and 'B')

- (2) <u>Dearness Allowance.</u> The employees referred to above, apart from the minimum rates of basic wages, are eligible for getting dearness allowance as detailed below:-
 - (i) The dearness allowance shall be linked to the Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index Number for the year 2010, that is 161 points (with base 2001 = 100) and for every raise of one point over and above 161 points, an increase of Rs. 1.20 (Rupee One and Twenty paise only) per day shall be paid as dearness allowance.
 - (ii) The dearness allowance shall be calculated every year on the first April on the basis of the average consumer price indices of the preceding twelve months, that is, from January to December.
 - (iii) The first calculation shall thus be effective from the date of publication of this Notification in the <u>Tamil Nadu Government Gazette</u> based on Average Chennai City Consumer Price Index Number for the previous year.
- (3) Where the nature of work is the same, no distinction in the payment of wages shall be made between men and women employees.
- (4) Wherever the existing wages are higher than the minimum wages fixed herein, the same higher wages shall be continued to be paid.
