ORDER:

The scope of the revolving fund viz., "Metropolitan Infrastructure Development Fund (MIDF)" created under the Union Government sponsored erstwhile "Mega City Program" has been recently expanded, enabling it to provide finance to all Urban Local Bodies in the State to meet their infrastructure requirements in the form of soft loans. The Fund has been renamed as "State Urban Infrastructure Development Fund (SUIDF)" and the State Level Sanctioning Committee under the Fund has also been restructured. Administrative sanction in this regard has been issued vide the Government Order first read above.

2. Earlier, the Government, vide the Orders third and fifth read above, have accorded administrative sanction among others for 18 water supply projects in various Municipalities at a total cost of Rs.564.29 crore

under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation 2.0 (AMRUT 2.0) as approved by the State High Powered Steering Committee of the Mission.

3. During the second meeting of the State Level Sanctioning Committee under State Urban Infrastructure Development Fund held on 13.10.2022, the Director of Municipal Administration requested to sanction Urban Local Bodies' share for the above 18 water supply projects in various Municipalities from the State Urban Infrastructure Development Fund and the State Level Sanctioning Committee among others, has approved for providing a loan of Rs.56.39 crore from the Fund, towards 50% of Urban Local Bodies' share for these 18 water supply projects in various Municipalities sanctioned under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation 2.0 at an interest rate of 4% per annum with repayment period of 10 year, as abstracted below and detailed in the Annexure, subject to the conditions specified in the appraisal report of respective projects:

Accordingly, the Additional Chief Secretary/ Chairman and Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Urban Finance and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited in his proposal sixth read above has requested the Government to issue necessary orders for providing loan for an amount of Rs.56.39 crore from the State Urban Infrastructure Development Fund towards 50% of Urban Local Bodies' share for 18 water supply projects in various Municipalities sanctioned under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation 2.0.

5. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Additional Chief Secretary / Chairman and Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Urban Finance and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited, have decided to accord permission for providing a loan of Rs.56.39 crore from State Urban Infrastructure Development Fund towards 50% of Urban Local Bodies' share for 18 water supply projects in various Municipalities sanctioned under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation 2.0 (Details are given in Annexure) at an interest rate of 4% per annum with repayment period of 10 year, subject to the conditions specified in the appraisal report of respective projects and as approved by the State Level Sanctioning Committee during its second meeting held on 13.10.2022 and order accordingly.
