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In the G.O. first read above, the Government constituted the Project Sanctioning Committee to approve the projects under Solid Waste Management Fund.

2. In the letter second read above, the Director of Municipal Administration has stated that during the 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting dated 04.02.2014 of the Project Sanctioning Committee, the following project was placed before the committee for approval, for the year 2013-2014:-

"Development and processing facility for handling of 100 Tones Per Day Construction and Demolition waste in the Coimbatore Corporation." 3. Financial arrangement for the above project is as follows:

The Committee had requested the Corporation to rework the model considering the risk associated with the project viz., by products and its marketability, quality of construction & demolition waste to be supplied and its collection & transportation etc. Further the Committee was also discussed to explore the possibilities on developing a "No Tipping Fee" model also with 100% viability gap filling fund involving the private developers to operate the facility under polluters pay principle.

4. Accordingly, the Director of Municipal Administration had furnished a revised proposal before the 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive meeting of the Committee dated 08.08.2014. As per the revised proposal, they proposed to implement the project by 100% investment under Engineering Planning Construction and Operation & Maintenance model with the financial assistance of 90% under Solid Waste Management Fund and balance 10% by the Corporation funds, as follows:-

The Director of Municipal Administration has requested the Government to accord Administrative Sanction for the project "Development and processing facility for handling of 100 Tones Per Day Construction and Demolition waste in the Coimbatore Corporation" and also to release a grant of Rs.1132.173 lakh (Rupees Eleven crore thirty two lakh seventeen thousand and three hundred) as 90% Government share under Solid Waste Management Fund in a biennial equal instalment viz., Rs.566.09 lakh for the year 2013-14 and 2014- 15 respectively.
- 6. The Government after careful examination of the above proposal of Director of Municipal Administration, according Administrative Sanction for the project "Development and Processing facility for handling of 100 tones per day construction & demolition waste in Coimbatore Corporation" at a cost of Rs.1257.96 lakh and sanctions a grant of Rs.1132.173 lakh (Rupees Eleven crore thirty two lakh seventeen thousand and three hundred only) as 90% Government share under Solid Waste Management Fund and release the same in a biennial equal instalment viz., Rs.566.09 lakh for the year 2013-14 and 2014- 15 respectively.
- 7. The amount sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-
